The Heat index reached 100° yesterday.

Today: Sunny with a high temperature near 95°, and a heat index near 98°. Winds will be SE at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies and a low near 74°, and SE winds at 5-10 mph.

Saturday: Mostly sunny skies and the high temperature will be near 94°, and a heat index near 99°. Here is a 30% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon and the wind will be light from the E-SE.

Saturday Night: Mostly clear, and a low temperature near 74°. There is a 30% chance of showers in the evening, with wind becoming calm.

Sunday: Partly sunny skies with a high temperature near 91°, and a 50% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon. Wind will be light from the NE.

Power Outage Wednesday Night

At around 6pm Wednesday evening, Lampasas residents in the far west part of town suffered a two hour power outage. It seems there was a structure fire in a outbuilding on Avenue E near the Oak Hill Cemetery entrance. That structure fire took out a feeder line that killed power in the area of Porter St. and parts west, though there were a few pockets outside that area that were affected. City utility crews, as well as firemen worked as fast as possible. The electric crew ran another line and managed to restore power to most of the area around 8pm.

Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety

As Texans travel to their destinations, TxDOT wants them to know the laws for safe walking, biking and driving—and to follow them. State laws mandate stopping for pedestrians in crosswalks, yielding the right of way to pedestrians and bicyclists when turning, and passing bicyclists at a safe distance and giving them room to ride.

Like drivers, bicyclists are required to obey all traffic signs and signals, including stopping at red lights and stop signs. State laws also dictate that those who ride bicycles must use hand signals when turning or stopping, ride with traffic, use bike lanes or ride as near as possible to the right-hand curb, and when riding at night, make sure their bikes have a white light on the front and a red light or reflector on the back.

Pedestrians must cross the street only at intersections and crosswalks, obey all traffic and crosswalk signals and always use sidewalks. If there isn't a sidewalk, pedestrians should walk on the left side of the street or road, facing oncoming traffic.

Between 2015 and 2021, TxDOT awarded more than \$300 million in federal and state funding to support locally-sponsored projects providing safe routes to schools, multiuse paths, sidewalks and bikeways in rural and small urban areas and to upgrade sidewalks, curb ramps and striping for pedestrian accessibility, safety, and mobility.

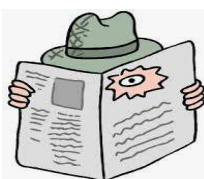

Street Repair in Lampasas

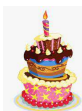
