## The Weather

The High yesterday 102°  
The Low this morning 78°

The Heat Index reached 101° in Lampasas yesterday.

The forecasters are looking for a new record high temperature at DFW today, the previous record being 106° in 2012 and 1911. Today and tomorrow look for exceptional heat with highs in the 105°-108° range. These will be actual temperatures, not a heat index and are dangerously high. Our neighboring counties of San Saba, Hamilton and Mills are under an excessive heat warning until 7pm Saturday, while Lampasas County is under a heat advisory. Heat safety needs to be taken seriously. But have faith, there is a cool (?) front slated to move through Sunday night bringing the high temperatures for the beginning of next week to the mid 90's.

**Today:** A heat advisory is in effect until Saturday at 7pm.

Hot and getting hotter with sunny skies and a high near 104°. Winds will be brisk from the south at 10-15 mph.

**Tonight:** The South wind continues at 10-15 mph with mostly clear skies and a low near 77°.


**Saturday:** Sunny and hot with a high temperature near 107°. Winds will be SW at 5-10 mph.

**Saturday night:** Look for partly cloudy skies with a low near 78°. Light E-SE wind shifting S-SW in the night.

**Sunday:** Mostly sunny and hot with a high near 103°.

S-SW wind at 5-10 mph will shift N-NE in the afternoon.

**Next week:** A 30% chance of showers and storms Sunday night and Monday decreasing Monday night.

## School's been in session a week

Dr. Chane Rascoe visited Lampasas Radio studios this morning to bring us up-to-date on everything school related.



Dr. Rascoe tells us that about 25% of the district's students are remote learning. With fewer kids in school, social distancing is much easier, and the elementary schools are averaging 15-16 kids in a classroom. The campuses have expanded their cafeteria areas so the kids stay distanced. He did say bus ridership is down, mostly due to remote learners. Almost all of the teachers returned, however Dr. Rascoe stated that at this time, the district only has about 20% of the substitutes they normally do. Custodians and bus drivers are needed as well.

The staff is excited about seeing the kids in the classrooms and in the hallways, he said it has been so long since the kids were there. The staff was understandably nervous and anxious, and concentrated on things that they were able to control to stay safe. Dr. Rascoe stresses we needed to get the kids back, and now we need to set goals. Long term and short term goals with a focus on education for the students. (cont'd on back)



## The Blotter



**Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Thursday** shows a criminal trespass reported in the 500 block of N. Ridge St. at 8:42am. The 600 block of Samac Ln. saw a harassment reported at 11:50am. The afternoon shows a theft in the 1400 block of W. Ave C at 12:30pm, then an abandoned vehicle was reported in the 1500 block of 281N at 4:38pm. A major accident was reported in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss Dr. at 6:32pm (see story). A minor accident took place at 6:42pm in the 1100 block of 580E, with no injuries. There was a reported harassment on Castleberry St. at 9:52pm, a disorderly conduct was reported in the 800 block of N. Key at 11:35pm, and a theft was reported on E. Ave F at 11:49pm.

**Lampasas Sheriff's** blotter for Thursday shows Lometa with an animal call. Kempner shows reports of suspicious activity, fish & game calls, livestock issues, a welfare check, a reported identity theft, and a repossession. Out in the county there were accidents, animal/livestock issues, medical calls civil matters, a reported harassment and a pursuit. Deputies went into Cove on reported disturbances, and medical calls.

*Our area is experiencing extreme fire danger this weekend with high temperatures above 105°, brisk S-SW winds and low humidity. Please use caution!*

With the new normal, though he said the goals need to be flexible. Making sure of the key things, mainly reading, and where individual students need to improve are most important. In the high school, continuing to make sure the students are ready for college or work is essential. The CTE classes are still offered with certifications at some jobs available at the high school level.

Some schools have teachers designated for remote learners, and at some campuses they have to do double duty. Dr. Rascoe asks that through all situations and phases of this year (so not normal), parents remain patient. There are so many details that need to be worked out. Some teachers are having to teach in classrooms *and* provide instruction to remote learners.

As far as COVID-19 information, Dr. Rascoe *stresses* to parents please screen your child before you send them to school. If they have any symptoms of COVID or the flu, keep them home!

*If there is a positive case*, and your child is affected, you will receive a letter from the school. Dr. Rascoe doesn't want parents to panic if this happens. If necessary, Dr. Hay will phone the parent/guardian for contact tracing. If there is direct contact, Dr. Hay will contact the parent.

If a student that is a classroom learner is quarantined, they will become a remote learner.

On to sports—LISD plans to live stream the football games and other sports, however it is still in the planning stages. So...the capacity of Badger Stadium at 50% is 625 people on the visitors side, and 1600 on the home side. For home tickets, sales will begin online on the Monday before the game for parents of participants (football, band, cheer, etc). On Tuesday tickets will be online for season ticket holders. Wednesday begins the sales for students and others who want to attend. Tickets for away games are still being hashed out.

Dr. Rascoe wants the community to know what a blessing the teachers and staff are, and to be able to have an entire week of school was empowering.

And, as always, thank you to the Lampasas Community and God Bless our school district.

## From Dr. Georgia Hay;

This is Georgia Hay, MD. My role as Lampasas Local Health Authority includes helping advise the school with regards to COVID-19 cases that occur in students of our districts as well as hard working staff members trying to provide educational instruction to our children. The TEA and Governor also dictate orders and mandates to make this school year as safe as it can be during this pandemic. I have been in communication with school officials to address concerns. There are known risks that we all take, myself included, with sending our kids to school, but I want you to know how hard everyone is working to make it the best possible situation. If a child or staff member tests positive with the sars-Cov2 virus which is the cause of COVID-19, and was infectious during school hours, parents of other children in that room will be notified. On most of the cases, I am calling personally to get the details of the timeline which is extremely important to determine the risk to others. For example, if someone tested positive but wasn't infectious (which occurs 48 hours prior to symptom onset) during school hours when children were present, then only others that they exposed would be contacted and asked to quarantine. All areas of the school are being cleaned and disinfected regularly and extra measures taken if there is a case confirmed. I do ask that utter and complete honesty is used when interviews are conducted, since only with that and cooperation are we going to help contain this disease. We will notify parents when there is a case that affects their son or daughter. If you are asked specifically to quarantine due to a close contact with someone who has been diagnosed, you should receive a phone call. Otherwise a generic letter may be sent to just state there is an active case at a certain campus. Throughout the year depending on cases in the facility, we may have to switch to virtual school at times. It's going to require lots of flexibility, but also responsibility to not increase the risks by not socially distancing and wearing the masks which have lowered the numbers in Texas in recent weeks. I know this is a nerve-racking time with still so much uncertainty. I assure you that I am doing my best to balance public safety with getting our kids the education they need. As we return to school in Lampasas ISD, please screening your child for COVID symptoms each day, which include:

Fever over 100.4 F taken by mouth

New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing

Loss of taste and/or smell

Diarrhea

Vomiting

Abdominal Pain

New onset of severe headache, especially if with fever
