City of Lampasas Solid Waste Update

CURBSIDE GARBAGE SERVICE

For Residents inside the City Limits your service days are either: Monday and Thursday (west side Key Avenue) or Tuesday and Friday (east side Key Avenue)

Please have your waste out by 7am. on your service day. Household garbage and yard waste are collected at the curb (unobstructed) and limited to a

combination of 5 containers with handles (32 gallons standard store-bought, no heavier than 50lbs)

and/or bags (no heavier than 35lbs). Barrels will not be serviced. Helpful Hints/Reminders; Trash container cannot be over filled, Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed outside of container, All trash must be in bags, no loose items, For the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we do require that, branches and tree trimmings be no greater than three inches (3") in diameter and be cut, tied and bundled in four foot (4') lengths weighing no more than thirty five pounds (35 lbs.). Please place all bundled brush outside of the container.

 \cdot Bulk items such as mattresses, couches, dressers etc. will be picked up on Thursday or Friday

depending on your regular service day and providing the max load requirement has not been

met. Please make sure couches/mattresses etc. remain dry. Refrigerators/Freezers/Air Conditioners must be tagged by service company that coolant/freon has been removed. Drivers will not pick up construction debris (for safety reasons) including but not limited to: sheetrock, tile, lumber, carpet & shingles- these are to be hauled by contractor. For unacceptable items for curbside service, call 1-800-350-3024 for special pickup. (Gasoline, Paint, Batteries, Vehicle Tires, Large Pieces of Metal Motor Oil (and used filters) Electronics(TV's).

Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 16 new confirmed cases in Lampasas county, The DSHS website estimates 215 actual cases in Lampasas County for yesterday.

Pedestrian/Bicycle Safety

As Texans travel to their destinations, TxDOT wants them to know the laws for safe walking, biking and driving—and to follow them. State laws mandate stopping for pedestrians in crosswalks, yielding the right of way to pedestrians and bicyclists when turning, and passing bicyclists at a safe distance and giving them room to ride.

Like drivers, bicyclists are required to obey all traffic signs and signals, including stopping at red lights and stop signs. State laws also dictate that those who ride bicycles must use hand signals when turning or stopping, ride with traffic, use bike lanes or ride as near as possible to the right-hand curb, and when riding at night, make sure their bikes have a white light on the front and a red light or reflector on the back.

Pedestrians must cross the street only at intersections and crosswalks, obey all traffic and crosswalk signals and always use sidewalks. If there isn't a sidewalk, pedestrians should walk on the left side of the street or road, facing oncoming traffic. (cont'd)


