Monday Meetings

Commissioners Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met this morning at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda included new fee requirements on jury service, a petition for a local election filed on July $14^{\rm th}$, presentation of the 2022 audit, discussion and a vote on the proposed tax rate for 2023 and setting a public hearing on the budget and tax rate, 2024 Sheriff's and Constable fees, and accepting the resignation of the Precinct 2 & 3 Constable, Misty Maldonado.

Lampasas City Council

The Lampasas City Council will meet today for regularly scheduled meetings beginning with a workshop session.

The agenda for the workshop session includes discussion regarding the following: city mural sign regulations, current drought and conservation stages, the fiscal year (FY) budget status and modifications, and the solar eclipse event.

The agenda for the regular session includes public hearings on the following: a request to amend the streets and sidewalk ordinances to allow for right-of-way use for construction, excavation or facility installation and associated fees, the plat for the 5.556 acres of the Moore Subdivision, a request to rezone the Lampasas Economic Development Corporation Business Park zoning from AG to Business Park Zoning, and the annexation of 12.74 acres around the Mockingbird Lane, Hereford Dr. and County Road 4004. The agenda also include the City Manager's Operational Report to include discussion of the Hostess House and the Calvert Building. New Business will include discussion and possible action regarding the first reading of ordinances to cover those items presented in the public hearings. The agenda includes discussion and possible action regarding the approval of a pole attachment agreement between Fiberlight, LLC and the City of Lampasas for use of the city's utility poles, a mural at Hester's Book Store located at 516 E. 4th St., the Proposed Tax Rate for the City of Lampasas and the scheduling of a public hearing for the Proposed Tax Rate.

The Council will then go into Executive Session relating to 'the authority of public power utility governing bodies to deliberate regarding competitive matters-utilities'. Council will then reconvene for action on executive session items

Water Supply Update

According to a memo released Friday, Kempner Water Supply Corporation (KWSC) will begin installing an extension on their intake that will allow deeper access to the lake. This should take about 3 days to complete. During the day KWSC customers will be using water from the storage tanks (cont'd on back)

According to the City of Lampasas, water will still be coming into the city's storage tanks. However, they stress that *water conservation is still needed at this time!* Please conserve where you can.

Pool Schedule Update

Lampasas Radio reached out to Chris Eicher, Parks Director at the City of Lampasas about an updated pool schedule. According to Mr. Eicher, Hanna Springs Pool is closed for the season with the exception of private parties and water aerobics. The city is trying to keep Hancock Pool open on the weekends through Labor Day, and is planning on September 4th as the last day of the season. Lap Swim has been moved to Hancock Pool.

This is contingent on being able to staff the pool with lifeguards. If there are not enough lifeguards available, this is subject to change.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on august 11th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 18 cases were brought to the court with 16 cases involving men and 2 cases involving women.

There were 9 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 5 cases for possession less than a gram, with 1 of those being in a drug free zone, there were 3 cases for possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams. There was 1 case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram in a drug free zone. There was 1 DWI case.

.There was 1 case each for bail jumping/failure to appear, burglary and evading arrest.

In crimes involving personal harm, there was 1 case for intoxication assault/serious bodily injury/w/vehicle.

There were 3 cases of aggravated sexual assault of a child and 1 case for continuous sexual abuse of a child under 14.

Of the 18 cases 4 were resolved with Izak Daniel of Brownwood pleading guilty on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram and was sentenced to time served (111 days) and court costs. On the charge of manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram in a drug free zone, Richard Adames plead guilty and was sentenced to 3 years probation plus court costs. Fabricio Bienbenu was found guilty of possession of a controlled substance PG1 and was sentenced to 6 months time served plus court costs. Oshaun Robinson, of Killeen was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ with credit for time served.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.
