## Lampasas Man Dies in Car Accident in Cove

Acording to the accident report from DPS: "Texas DPS responded to a report of a two vehicle crash south of Copperas Cove at 12:26pm on Saturday August 12th. A 2007 BMW passenger car, operated by Bernard Christian Uhler II, 48, of Lampasas, Texas, was traveling southbound on FM 116. A 2023 Toyota pickup, operated by a 46-year-old male from Copperas Cove, Texas, was traveling northbound.

According to the Trooper investigating the crash, the BMW crossed over the center turn lane, traveled into the northbound lane, and collided head on into the Toyota pickup. The Toyota was fully engulfed in flames after the collision. The 46-year-old driver, and a 42-year-old passenger of the Toyota escaped with minor injuries.

Uhler II was pronounced deceased on scene by Justice of the Peace Frank Price. Next of kin have been notified.


#### In Lampasas Studios

## Wildfire Disaster Declaration for ¾ of Texas

Governor Greg Abbott yesterday announced that he has issued a disaster declaration for 191 Texas counties in response to widespread wildfire activity throughout the state. Additional counties may be added as conditions warrant. Lampasas County as well as all surrounding counties are included in the disaster declaration.

"The State of Texas continues working with local officials to respond to critical wildfire activity across the entire state," said Governor Abbott. "I issued a disaster declaration to surge the deployment of additional resources and assistance to 191 counties currently experiencing dangerous wildfire conditions. As we continue to respond to wildfire conditions across the state, Texas is ready to provide any additional resources and aid to impacted communities. I commend the bravery and service of the hundreds of emergency personnel and firefighters who have swiftly responded to the wildfires to protect their fellow Texans and communities. Texans are encouraged to remain weather-aware and heed the guidance of state and local officials."

According to the Texas A&M Forest Service, wildfire activity is expected to continue as high temperatures and dry conditions persist. Critical fire weather is forecasted for Central and East Texas, with the risk increasing mid-week.
