Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 4,209 new and 889 probable new cases on 8/15/21, along with 43 deaths. There were also 11,552 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows -13 new confirmed cases in Lampasas county on August 14th, and 160 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas county to have 206 active cases at this time which is down a little bit from last week.

Railroad Track Safety

An average freight train is 4,000 times heavier than your car, so don't risk a collision when driving near railroad tracks. Never pass other vehicles at a crossing. If your car gets stuck on the crossing, immediately leave your vehicle and move away from it. Call 911 to report an emergency.

When you're in the vicinity of railroad tracks, stay alert! Only cross at marked crossings, and never ever walk on or along the tracks. Don't wear headphones or get distracted by taking photos. And, very important: If you're crossing multiple tracks, remember there can be multiple trains at any time. Keep your eyes and ears open, and most of all, #stayoffthetracks.

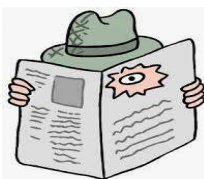

City of Lampasas Solid Waste Update

CURBSIDE GARBAGE SERVICE

For Residents inside the City Limits your service days are either: Monday and Thursday (west side Key Avenue) or Tuesday and Friday (east side Key Avenue). Please have your waste out by 7am. on your service day. Household garbage and yard waste are collected at the curb (unobstructed) and limited to a combination of 5 containers with handles (32 gallons standard store-bought, no heavier than 50lbs) and/or bags (no heavier than 35lbs). Barrels will not be serviced.

Helpful Hints/Reminders; Trash container cannot be over filled, Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed outside of container, All trash must be in bags, no loose items, For the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we do require that, branches and tree trimmings be no greater than three inches (3") in diameter and be cut, tied and bundled in four foot (4') lengths weighing no more than thirty five pounds (35 lbs.). Please place all bundled brush outside of the container. Bulk items such as mattresses, couches, dressers etc. will be picked up on Thursday or Friday, depending on your regular service day and providing the max load requirement has not been met. Please make sure couches/mattresses etc. remain dry. Refrigerators/Freezers/Air Conditioners must be tagged by service company that coolant/freon has been removed.
