Tonight: Clear skies and the low will get down to about 79° and the wind will be SE near 10 mph becoming S-SW overnight.


Friday: Look for sunny skies and a high temperature near 107°. Wind will be SW near 10 mph shifting SE in the afternoon.

Local Fire Departments Busy Yesterday

The Lampasas, Lometa and Adamsville Volunteer Fire Departments responded to multiple fires yesterday.

According to the Lampasas VFD, the first fire was on Lampasas County Road 2275 due to some live power wires igniting surround dry grasses. The Lampasas VFD, the City of Lampasas Fire Department and the Lometa VFD were on the scene of that fire. Lometa VFD Chief Bobby Odom said that Lometa then had a small fire that was extinguished, and Connie Green from Kempner shared that Kempner had an RV next to a home catch on fire, but was also extinguished quickly with no damage to the home.

Later yesterday afternoon a large grass fire ignited from a resident burning trash off of Lampasas County Road 3900 north of Adamsville. Fire crews were able to stop the fire from spreading and according to the Texas A & M Forestry Service as of 11:18 last night, the Spotted Opossum Fire (as it was named) was 110 acres and 65% contained.

The Lampasas VFD, along with The City of Lampasas Fire Department, Levita VFD, Evant VFD, Gatesville Fire Department, Adamsville VFD, Lometa VFD, TIFMAS, Texas Forestry Service, and Oklahoma Forestry Service (part of a task force based in Gatesville, the one with the large aircraft), responded. There were 2 helicopters and 4 smaller bush planes doing water drops as well. Forestry crews and fire crews remained on scene overnight to make sure it didn't start to spread again, and will be on scene today conducting mop up.

Yesterday was the 47th 100°+ day this summer; we have had no measurable rain in 46 days, since July Second.

Our local volunteer fire departments have been out on the front lines of these fires, and could use some donations from our communities of water and Gatorade. The Lampasas VFD will take donations at the Lampasas Fire Department at 1107 E. 4th St. For the Adamsville VFD, you can drop off donated water or Gatorade at Lampasas Car Care with Rusty by the Lampasas Middle School. And the Lometa City Hall will be the drop-off point for donations of water and Gatorade for the Lometa VFD.
