ERCOT

ERCOT, The state's electric grid operator asked residents yesterday to reduce their power use between 3 and 8pm when forecasters expected to see high demand for electricity because of extremely hot temperatures that are baking the state. This is the second such request that grid operators have made this summer. The call does not mean the grid is in emergency conditions, but is a way for operators to try to lower demand when conditions look tight — which typically occurs late in the day when it's still hot and people return home from work.

Electricity users have exceeded the record for power demand on the state's main grid 10 times so far this summer, according to ERCOT data.



San Saba Fire

(KWTX) Firefighters in San Saba Thursday afternoon contained a massive fire along U.S. Highway 190 in San Saba. The blaze was reported at about 2:15 p.m., according to San Saba Police Chief John Bauer, who said investigators are still working to determined how the fire erupted. "Foul play is not suspected at this time," Bauer said. The structure fire was burning in the 2700

block of West Wallace (U.S. Highway 190) across the highway from the Chase Pecan company, and near the Heart of Texas Propane facility. Lee Murray, the assistant chief with the San Saba Volunteer Fire Department, said they are not yet sure what type of structure burned to the ground. He said cardboard boxes and plastic bags were torched at the property. Residents near the scene of the fire had to be evacuated while crews worked to extinguish the blaze, which burned about five acres, according to Murray.

The Texas Forestry Service responded to Burnet County Road 219 in far northeast Burnet County to a wildfire yesterday afternoon. The Burnt Oak fire, as they are calling it is 13 acres and was 95% contained last night at midnight. However, the local fire department advises to continue to avoid the area as there are still crews working the fire.

From TxDOT

As Labor Day approaches, TxDOT is reminding all Texans about the dangers of drunk driving. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration has announced an increased enforcement period from August 18th to September 4th. Texas law enforcement agencies are among those that will increase their efforts to pull over motorists suspected of drunk driving.

"Too many people are killed on our roads each year—especially during holidays—due to impaired driving. These crashes are inexcusable and 100% preventable," said TxDOT Executive Director Marc Williams. "If you spend time with friends or family and decide to drink, make the right decision and plan ahead for a sober ride by taking a rideshare, taxi, public transit or designated driver."

The harsh reality is people continue to choose to drive after drinking. Last year, there were 345 DUI-alcohol related traffic crashes over the Labor Day holiday weekend alone, resulting in 20 fatalities and 62 serious injuries. Over the course of the year, a person was killed every 7 hours and 17 minutes in Texas because of a DUI-alcohol-related traffic crash, resulting in 1,203 people losing their lives.

The increased enforcement period comes as a new law is set to take effect on Sept. 1 that will require someone convicted of intoxication manslaughter to pay child support if they kill a parent with young children.
