The forecast highs near 100° today will be bearable because of the drier airmass in place, as well as a NE breeze. Over the weekend we may see a few heat indices near 100°, which is seasonal.

Today: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 100°, and winds will be NE near 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Mostly clear skies and a low near 69°. The wind will become light in the evening.

Thursday: Sunny with a high temperature near 97°. The wind will become E near 5 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear and a low around 72°. Winds will become calm in the evening.

Friday: Mostly sunny and up to 99° with S winds at 5 mph.

In Texas, 7,282 new cases were reported yesterday. There are 6,210 Texans in the hospital. The State of Texas has had more than 200 deaths per day for almost 3 weeks.

City Manager's Notes



Lampasas City Manger Finley

de Graffenried was in Lampasas Radio studios this morning for a visit with Ronnie Witcher.

They spoke about the 'Mask Mandate', and how city employees wear masks when dealing with the public. Lampasas County is

down to 17 active cases of Covid-19, so the City Manager feels the residents of the county are keeping the virus under control.

Mr. Witcher asked again about economic fallout from the pandemic, and again was reassured that as far as the city knows, no businesses are closing, and that though at a lower number, the city continues to be contacted by companies wanting to start businesses or move to our area. Also, construction permits have not slowed down.

Mr. de Graffenreid stated that the City Council provided input about the upcoming budget for the fiscal year. Their priorities included upgrades to the hostess house, major equipment purchases for the Street Dept., and park improvements at WM Brook Park. The budget also addresses needs from the capital improvement program; because the city is financially healthy we are able to work on some of these projects.

The areas where the city wrestles with the budget, are with various departments about where staff is needed, or combining positions to create more efficiency, and how to deliver the resources the city has to offer.

The City Manager assured us that the tax rate will stay the same, with no increases in fees, or utility rates or other fees assessed by the city.

This will be the last weekend for the Hancock free-flow pool, it will be closing for fall.

In the General Election in November, City Council places 3,4 & 5 are being voted on. Early voting starts on October 13th. Those that feel they are at risk by voting in person can request a mail-in ballot.

West Avenue E is continues to be closed in sections as they put in drainage, so residents are asked to use caution and take another route if possible.

Fires at Ft. Hood

FORT HOOD, TX — Live fire training exercises have sparked three fires on Fort Hood.

Officials say the blazes are burning near Brown's Creek, Clabber Creek and Jack Mountain.

Firefighters have extinguished 12 acres at the Brown's Creek fire and two acres at the Clabber Creek fire. Officials say the Jack Mountain fire is still burning and has burned about 50 acres.



The fires are not threatening any structures and are contained within Fort Hood. Officials are not asking for any outside help at this time.

There are currently five vehicles on the ground battling the blazes, including one water tended and two command units.
