**Lampasas County is under an Excessive Heat Warning until 9pm Sunday**

**Today:** Skies will be sunny with a high temperature near 105°. Winds will be from the SW at 5-10 mph shifting SE in the afternoon.

**Tonight:** Look for clear skies with a low near 77°. Wind will be from the SE near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph becoming SW overnight.

**Sunday:** The high temperature will climb to near 106° with sunny skies. Wind will be W-SW near 5-10 mph shifting E in the afternoon.

**Sunday Night:** Overnight it gets down to 80° with mostly clear skies. Wind will be E-SE near 5-10 mph becoming S-SW overnight.

**Monday:** Look for sunny skies with a high temperature near 105°. There will be a S-SW wind near 5-15 mph shifting E in the afternoon gusting to 20 mph.

**Monday Night:** Mostly clear skies with a low around 79°. Wind will be S-SE near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.



## Fire Danger

Thursday, Texas A&M Forest Service responded to 20 new requests for assistance on wildfires that burned 2,917 acres across the state.

Through Monday, a very high volume of wildfire activity is expected to continue for a broad area of Texas due to extremely dry vegetation, intense heat and dry conditions.

High-risk juniper/oak fuel will support a moderate risk for a significant fire along and west of I-35 through Monday for the Eastern/Western Hill Country with periods of elevated fire weather over extremely dry vegetation. Oak/Juniper fuel will support active crown fire in these regions.

A *Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory* has been reissued for Central and East Texas, and is effective August 14th:

(cont'd from front) "Subject: A flash drought is ongoing for the areas of concern due to persistent above normal temperatures and below normal rainfall. This drought follows an early growing season where above normal rainfall resulted in a robust and continuous stand of grass across the Central Texas landscape. This continuous grass fuel bed facilitates the ignition and spread of wildfires as the grass wilts and cures in the Texas heat and drought. The flash drought and underlying dryness have unlocked the availability of large dead fuels and canopy fuels for combustion. These fuels are now contributing to fire behaviors that increase the resistance to control of wildfires burning in oak/juniper fuel beds across Central Texas.

### Concerns to Firefighters and the Public:

- Extreme fireline intensity is to be expected during both initial attack and extended attack. Currently, only elevated fire weather is required to produce extreme fire line intensities and high crown fire potential.
- Typical barriers to fire spread like roadways, rivers, and hardwood river bottoms cannot be relied upon to stop fire progression.
- Active fire behavior may extend into the overnight hours due to poor overnight moisture recovery.
- Spotting has routinely been reported on most recent fires, including small initial attack fires

*Yesterday marked the 49<sup>th</sup> 100°+ day for Lampasas this year and the 15<sup>th</sup> day of 105°+ days. It has been 48 days since the Lampasas Airport has had measurable rain. Stillhouse Hollow Lake is at 605.05 feet elevation this morning.*
