The Weather

The high yesterday 96° This morning's low 65°
Look for seasonal weather today, hot and dry. Winds will shift eastward, but the humidity is slow to return. The heat index will stay close to actual temperatures again. The moisture in the air will increase, along with the temperatures over the rest of the week and the weekend.

Today: Sunshine and a 97° high temperature this afternoon, with N winds near 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Partly cloudy, with a low around 71° and E winds of 5-10 mph.

Friday: Mostly sunny and hot, with a high about 99° and south wind near 5 mph.

Overnight Friday it will drop to about 72° and the wind will be S at 5 mph. There is a 30% chance of precipitation in the night.

Saturday: A 20% chance of showers and storms through the morning, then mostly sunny with high temperatures near 96°. Winds will be SE at 5 mph.

Saturday night, look for mostly clear skies and a low near 71°, with light S-SW winds.



Grass Fire off FM1715

Ronnie Withers, Fire Marshall for Lampasas, shared with Lampasas Radio this morning that the brush fire of FM 1715 to the East of Lampasas was

between 160 and 175 acres. (picture)

The fire started on the roadside somewhere, though the investigation continues. The humidity yesterday was low, near 20%,

and wind were gusting to 30mph. As we were told this morning, this is fire danger season.

The Fire Marshall stressed that residents that are pulling trailers need to make sure the safety chain does not drag on the road, (he thinks this may be how the fire started yesterday), please make sure they are in a safe position to travel. Also please do not throw cigarettes out the windows and exercise extreme caution.

The Kempner Volunteer Fire Dept. and the Copperas Cove Fire Dept. handled a grass fire off FM 2657 as well yesterday. The fires at Ft. Hood continue to burn according to the Killeen Daily Herald. "Range fires on Fort Hood are still being fought by fire personnel on the base. Fort Hood officials said Wednesday afternoon the fires are around 60% contained and have consumed around 70 acres. However, there is no current threat to people or property, according to Fort Hood officials."

Unemployment Benefits on the Way?

According to an article with KWTX, Texas Gov. Greg Abbott is asking the federal government for additional unemployment benefits authorized in an executive order that President Donald Trump issued. Abbott asked the Texas Workforce Commission Wednesday to start the application process for funds for a \$400 weekly supplement in unemployment benefits authorized by the Lost Wage Assistance Executive Order. Under the terms of the order, the state must contribute \$100 of the \$400. The funds are meant to help replace an emergency benefit of \$600 that expired at the end of July.

It's still unclear how long the application process will take, or how long it will take to get the relief funds out to unemployed Texans.

The Texas Tribune reports that there is confusion over the payments that has persisted as the state and the federal government have not said when or whether those funds will be available in Texas. Trump announced the extra money in early August, but questions remain over whether his executive order authorizing it was legal and whether states will be able to afford to implement it.

In the ensuing days, the state agency in charge of unemployment relief, the Texas Workforce Commission, has not had answers for unemployed Texans seeking the benefits. The agency "was waiting on further guidance from the U.S. Department of Labor and will provide additional information as soon as it becomes available," spokesperson Cisco Gamez said in a statement Wednesday.
