## The Weather

High yesterday was 97° Low this morning was 64° 

The storm that rolled in between 4am & 5am today brought Lampasas a 37 mph wind gust at about 4:35am. The temperature dropped 6 degrees in 20 minutes from 70° at 4:35am to 64° at 4:55am. The airport is showing .01 inches of rain from the storm. (Burnet received 1.24 inches this morning)

**Today:** A 40% chance of storms this morning, then gradual clearing with a high temperature near 95°. The heat index could be close to 100°. Winds will be light from the E-NE this afternoon.

**Tonight:** Mostly clear with a low near 71°. Winds will become calm.

**Sunday:** Sunny with a high temperature near 95°. The wind will be E at 5-10 mph.

**Sunday Night:** Mostly clear with a low temperature near 71°. Winds will be E-SE at 5-10 becoming light and variable.

**Monday:** Skies will be sunny with a high temperature near 97°. Winds will be light from the east.

**Monday Night:** A low near 72° and mostly clear skies. Wind will be from the E at 5-10 mph becoming calm

Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth; Sore throat; New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (or, for students with a chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline); Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

The National Weather Service tells us that the first, Tropical Storm Marco, will be moving across the Gulf toward the Texas Coast. As Marco reaches the Texas Coast Tuesday afternoon, the showers and storms should move inland impacting Central and East Texas Counties.

The Houston/Galveston NWS office shared that tropical Storm Laura is expected to move toward the eastern Gulf of Mexico before making landfall and should not have a major impact on Texas.. If both storms become hurricanes in close proximity, they may interact, and they could impact each other's velocity, although it's uncertain how at the moment. Models are changing every six hours. Marco's eventual dissolution once it makes landfall may be affected by Tropical Storm Laura.

The forecasters say the storms should be moving out of Texas by Friday.

## Road Work in County



The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Brownwood District will complete the annual maintenance sealcoat project in Lampasas County next week.

TxDOT's contractor will move to FM 2313 (from FM 580 to US 190) on Monday morning. Crews will then

work on US 281 (from the Coryell County Line to Adamsville) Tuesday.

Upon completion of US 281, the project will continue on the following roadways in Lampasas:

FM 2808 (US 190 to FM 2657)

FM 2657 (FM 2808 to the Burnet County Line)

FM 1478 (FM 580 to the Burnet County Line)

It is anticipated that work will be completed Tuesday, September 1, 2020, weather permitting.

Various lane closures will occur while work is underway. Motorists are asked to use an alternate route to avoid possible delays. A pilot car will guide traffic through these work zones. Motorists are asked to use caution and reduce their speed in work zones.
