The Weather

Today: Look for mostly sunny skies with a high near 102° and a 20% chance of showers late this afternoon. Wind will be E near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies with the low dropping to about 76° by morning and a slight chance of precipitation. Wind will be E-SE near 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny and hot with a high temperature near 102°. Look for wind to continue from the E-SE near 5-10 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Wednesday Night: Look for mostly clear skies with a low near 79° and a SE wind at 5-10 mph shifting W-SW overnight.

Thursday: Sunny skies and the high will be near 104° with W wind near 5-10 mph shifting SE in the afternoon.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low near 81° and SE wind near 10 mph becoming SW overnight.

* Yesterday was the 52nd day of triple digits this year and the 6th consecutive day of temperatures over 100°. Stillhouse Hollow Lake is at 604.86 feet elevation this morning.

Red Flag Warning Issued

The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning for Lampasas County from 10am-9pm today. Lampasas County is expected to experience critical fire danger this afternoon with temperatures expected to reach 102-107 degrees, east winds gusting to 25 mph and a relative humidity of 23-30%. Not to mention how dry all the grasses and trees are. No outdoor burning of any kind is permitted during a red flag warning.

According to the Texas A & M Forest Service, as the tropical depression moves across South Texas, a tightening pressure gradient between the depression and the upper-level ridge over the central United States will increase wind speeds and result in critical fire weather. Critical fire weather aligned with widespread critically to extremely dry fuels will result in high significant fire potential today and tomorrow for Central Texas. A Fuels and Fire Behavior Advisory has been issued for Central Texas. It has been 51 days since the Lampasas Airport recorded any measurable rain.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on August 1i8th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 34 cases were brought to the court with 29 cases involving men and 5 cases involving women. Carol Crim failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram.

There were 9 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 5 cases for possession less than a gram,

there was 1 case for possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams. There were 2 cases for possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams, and one case for manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams. There was one case for possession of a controlled substance PG2 4-400 grams and one case for possession of a controlled substance PG2 1-4 grams. There were 3 DWI cases.

There were 2 cases for burglary, and 1 case each for tampering with evidence, fraud, evading arrest w/vehicle, unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon, theft, forgery and criminal mischief.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 2 cases for assaulting a family member, and 1 case each for abandoning/endangering a child and deadly conduct (discharge of a firearm).

There were 3 cases of aggravated sexual assault of a child and 1 case each for indecency with a child/sexual contact and sexual assault of a child. There were 2 cases for failing to comply with sex offender registration.

Of the 41 cases 8 were resolved with Lial Carey pleading guilty to burglary of a building and being sentenced to 6 months State Jail with credit for time served. On the charge of theft of property, Jonathan Diehl of Lometa was sentenced to 5 years probation with the condition of attending ISF. Rashad Parkinson of Copperas Cove was sentenced to 12 years TDCJ for sexual assault of a child. David Hyland of Houston saw his charge reduced to a misdemeanor and was sentenced to 2 years probation, a fine, court costs and a DPS fee. Joshua Tryon on the charge of forgery was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ probated for 5 years plus a fine and restitution. On a 2nd charge of criminal mischief, Mr. Tryon was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ probated for 5 years. On the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1less than a gram, Tyler McMillian plead guilty and was sentenced to 4 years probation plus court costs and a fine. Hailey Evans saw her probation extended for 2 years plus the condition of attending SAFPF on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.
