## The Weather

## Lampasas City Council

Lampasas City Council met Monday evening and wrestled with a number of issues. The City administrators have been working on a new budget for the fiscal year that starts on October 1st. The budget and proposals they are now working on would see a property tax rate of \$.3156 per hundred dollar valuation. That would bring a tax of \$315.60 on a \$100,000 value home. With the recent increases in property values and resulting appraisals, that could easily bring about higher taxes for home and business properties. The rate suggested is just below the maximum that can be put into place before giving the citizens the right to vote on it. The council voted unanimously to proceed with the matter and a public hearing should be coming about soon.

In other matters the Fire Chief gave a report on his department's activities over the past year. The FD was called out 1,443 times up to August 22nd. He said the majority of those calls were for

accidents or medical emergencies, about 70%, but they were called out 124 times on fires.

Water rates were raised for the new year, probably about \$3 per month, and there was a great deal of discussion on the project of building a fence around the Hanna Spring Pool. The County Historical Foundation asked to be allowed to take over the project, but Council refused, opting instead to go out for bids for a contractor to come in and do the work, at the City's expense and the City's management.

## District Court Notes

**Lampasas County Courthouse** was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on August 19th. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 30 cases were brought to the court with 22 cases involving men, and 8 cases involving women. There were 11 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 7 cases for less than a gram, 3 cases for 1-4 grams, and 1 case for 4-200 grams. There was 1 DWI case.

There were 4 burglary cases, three for evading arrest and 1 each for debit/credit card abuse, impersonating a public servant, one case for taking wildlife resources without consent and 2 cases for theft.

In crimes involving personal harm, there was one case each of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon, assault of a family member, interference with child custody, abandoning/ endangering a child and violating a bond/protective order. There was 1 case of sexual assault of a child.

Of the 30 cases 11 were resolved with Charles Anderson pleading guilty to debit card abuse and sentenced to 31 days in the county jail with credit for time served plus court costs. Shawn Wood saw his charge of impersonating a public servant reduced to a misdemeanor, pled guilty, and was sentenced to 2 years probation plus court costs and a fine. Ricky Wilson of Amarillo pled guilty to possession of a (*cont'd on back*)

Elijah Helzer of Kempner pled guilty to two charges of evading arrest w/a vehicle and was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ plus court costs on each charge, with credit for time served. Bernard Uhler saw his charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams dismissed. Ronnie Romo, in court on 3 charges, pled guilty to burglary of a habitation and was sentenced to 8 years probation with SAFFP plus court costs. On the charges of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram and burglary of a building, Romo was sentenced to 5 years probation on each charge with SAFFP as a stipulation of each sentence, plus court costs.
