## The Weather

**The High yesterday 92° The Low this morning 69°**



Today will be seasonably hot and dry. Hurricane Marco is set to reach the Louisiana Coast this evening, and drift to the west.

Hurricane Laura will move into the Gulf of Mexico, and move to the northwestern Gulf to make landfall mid-week, moving out of the area late this week. However, the storm will leave behind significant humidity and some rain chances.

**Today:** Look for sunny skies and a high near 96°. Winds will be N at 5-10 mph shifting to the E mid-day.

**Tonight:** Skies will be mostly clear with a low temperature near 71°. Winds will be E at 5-10 mph shifting E-NE after midnight.

**Tuesday:** Sunny skies and a high near 96°. Winds will be light from the NE.

**Tuesday Night:** Look for mostly clear skies overnight, with a low temperature near 73°, and a slight chance of precipitation overnight. Winds will be E-NE at 5-10 mph becoming light and variable.

**Wednesday:** Mostly sunny with a high near 94° and light NE breezes. There is 30% chance of showers and storms.

**Wednesday Night:** Partly cloudy with a low near 74°, and light E-NE winds becoming calm. There is a 20% chance of showers and storms.

## Meetings Today

**The Lampasas County Commissioners** met this morning at 9am in the upstairs courtroom in the County Courthouse. The meeting was not available on ZOOM. The consent agenda was approved, as well as account payable and payroll and a bill from Roll Call Communications for \$345.

A voluntary subdivision plat located at Two Creeks Ranch, North of Lometa was approved. A revision for the final subdivision plat for Lampasas River Place II for putting in an entrance was approved.

A contract agreement for Regulatory Consulting with England Engineering was discussed. The company will be assisting the county with development. The county is now working to get signatures on the contract. An hourly rate for the Regulatory Consulting agreement was approved at \$125.00 an hour, with an annual cap of \$25,000 dollars.

The commissioners court held a discussion concerning a request for proposals for custodial services at the Annex Buildings 1 and 2, The Court house, and the New Sheriff's office. A bid request will be published through the auditor's office. This position is already included in the budget.

The commissioners discussed the 5 year "bump" pay incentive plan. Under this plan, employees receive a pay increase after 5 years of service. Right now there are 5 employees who will qualify for the year 2020 and one employee who will be eligible in Feb. of 2021. It was approved to honor the "bump" 5-year pay plan for these workers. After those six employees the 5 year pay plan will no longer be honored..

A donation was accepted in the amount of \$25,000 for road materials. It has been requested that the materials be used for chip seal paving off FM 581 to CR 2722, to the entrance of the Shoot-

ing Star platted subdivision.

It was brought up that Veterans and veteran widows could qualify for a TVC Grant. This is a grant for veterans for home repairs including foundation repairs, weatherization and other repairs. Qualified Veterans could receive a loan of up to \$15,000 dollars for repairs. The Veteran then would need to pay back 8% over a 12 month period with no interest. You can apply for the grant at the Annex Building in the Veteran's Services office room #212. As for the Jail project they are still dealing with billing issues with the electricity. They are working on electrical repairs and insulation. A construction meeting will be held this Thursday on the 27<sup>th</sup>.

**The Lampasas City Council** will meet this afternoon at 5:30pm for a workshop session. On the agenda for the workshop session are discussions/updates regarding the Heart of Texas Defense Alliance, the fiscal year 2020-2021 budget, the covid-19 pandemic, the Lampasas Skate park, and a community garden. Immediately following the workshop session, Council will go into a special session. In the special session, Council will adjourn into Executive Session for "discussion and possible action concerning items posted and discussed by council in Executive Session".

**The Lampasas City Council** regular session will begin at 6pm. The agenda includes; the consent agenda, departmental reports, the City Manager's operational report, and discussion regarding Pole attachment agreements with Nextlink and Roll Call Communications, the lease of 40 electric Yamaha rental carts and 2 gasoline Yamaha utility carts for the Hancock Golf Course, the audit engagement letter for the city, a City of Lampasas Skatepark, a City of Lampasas Community Garden, and to seek permission to move forward with Cardinal Tracking Systems.
