The agenda includes community input, a public hearing regarding the 2021-2022 budget and tax rate, consideration of the budget and tax rate, consideration of a resolution regarding extended leave during the Covid-19 Pandemic, filing for English Second Language Waiver, LEA Self-Certification increase of Federal Grant Micro Purchasing Limits including consideration to amend CH Policy, administrative and personnel reports.

FDA Approves Pfizer Vaccine

Yesterday, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration approved the first COVID-19 vaccine. The vaccine has been known as the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine, and will now be marketed as Comirnaty (koe-mir'-na-tee), for the prevention of COVID-19 disease in individuals 16 years of age and older. The vaccine also continues to be available under emergency use authorization (EUA), including for individuals 12 through 15 years of age and for the administration of a third dose in certain immunocompromised individuals.

"The FDA's approval of this vaccine is a milestone as we continue to battle the COVID-19 pandemic. While this and other vaccines have met the FDA's rigorous, scientific standards for emergency use authorization, as the first FDA-approved COVID-19 vaccine, the public can be very confident that this vaccine meets the high standards for safety, effectiveness, and manufacturing quality the FDA requires of an approved product," said Acting FDA Commissioner Janet Woodcock, M.D. "While millions of people have already safely received COVID-19 vaccines, we recognize that for some, the FDA approval of a vaccine may now instill additional confidence to get vaccinated. Today's milestone puts us one step closer to altering the course of this pandemic in the U.S."

Upcoming Vaccine Clinic

There is a vaccination clinic scheduled Wednesday, September 1st at the Lampasas Fire Dept. This will be done by the Texas Army National Guard, and they will have the Pfizer vaccination for those 12 years of age and older.

Coronavirus Update

According to the DSHS, statewide, 4,809 new cases were reported on August 23rd and there were 917 probable cases and 29 fatalities. 13,346 Texans are hospitalized with the virus. Locally, on August 23rd, the DSHS reported Lampasas with 13 new cases, and there have been 160 confirmed in Lampasas County in the last 14 days. The state estimate was 219 active cases yesterday.
