Public Tax Hearing for City of Lampasas

The City of Lampasas will have a Public Hearing on the tax increase for the 2021 tax year. The proposed new tax rate is \$0.3370 per \$100, up from the \$0.3217 per \$100 of last year. A Public Hearing will be held on September 7th at 5:30pm in the City Council Chambers 302 E. 3rd St. Lampasas.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate (\$0.3530 per \$100). As a result, the City of Lampasas is not required to hold an election at which votes may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. Executive Order GA-39 From the Governor

Governor Abbott yesterday issued an Executive Order maintaining the current policy prohibiting the mandating of any COVID-19 vaccinations by any government entity in the State of Texas. Additionally, the Governor added to the Special Session agenda the issue of whether any state or local governmental entities in Texas can mandate that an individual receive a COVID-19 vaccine and, if so, what exemptions should apply to such mandate.

"Vaccine requirements and exemptions have historically been determined by the legislature, and their involvement is particularly important to avoid a patchwork of vaccine mandates across Texas," said Governor Abbott.

Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, statewide there were 18,826 new and 5,289 probable new cases on August 25th, along with 233 deaths, and 13,928 in the hospital.

Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 22 new confirmed cases yesterday with the 14 day total at 184 cases. The DSHS website estimates Lampasas at 236 active cases.
