The Weather



The High yesterday 100° Low this morning 76°

Today: A high temperature near 98°, and a heat index of 103°, partly sunny with S wind at 5-10 mph becoming SE in the afternoon. A 20% chance of showers and storms after 10am.

With the lower rain chances in Central Texas, hot conditions, near heat advisory level will continue. Due to the possible cloud cover, and the possibility of rain, a Heat Advisory was not issued. However, if conditions warrant, one will be issued this afternoon.

Tonight: Rain chances increase to 30% mainly after 1am. Otherwise, mostly clear with a low near 74°, and E wind 5-10 mph becoming S after midnight.

Wednesday: The rain chances continue at 30% through the morning and until about lunchtime. Partly sunny with a high near 94° and heat index values as high as 97°, E-NE wind at 5 mph.

Wednesday Night: Partly cloudy with a low near 75°, and E wind near 5 mph.

The rest of the week: High temperatures near 96°, and lows in the mid-70's. A 20% chance of showers returns on Friday.

Commissioner's Court Notes

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met Monday morning, and Derrick Berrios from the Lampasas County Higher Education Center (LCHCEC) gave a report.

LCHCEC is celebrating its 10th anniversary in March of 2020. Since 2011 over 550 students have been certified through the Allied Health Training offered at our facility. Berrios relayed that the main goal is to provide workforce training.

Over 700 children have been provided with educational summer courses since 2012, and over all 3000 students have passed through their doors.

He also stated that as a non-profit organization, LCHCEC relies on donations. In the event they are not awarded a grant for the fiscal year, there will be a deficit that would need to be filled by donors.

While it was discussed, no action was taken regarding the vacancy of the Constable position in precinct 4.

The proposed tax rate was discussed, and there will be a public hearing on Thursday, September 5th at 6:30pm in the annex conference room, and another on September 19th, also at 6:30 in the annex conference room.

City Council Meets

The Lampasas City Council met yesterday evening with the workshop session beginning at 5:30pm, followed by the regular session.

The regular session began with a scheduled public on the proposed tax revenue increase. The city read the proposed tax plan, and there was no public input.



After that a proclamation of September as Library Card Sign-up Month began the meeting, and this proclamation was approved by Mayor Misti Talbert.

The HOT (Hotel Occupancy Tax) Fund request from the Chamber of Commerce for Artober Fest, which will be held October 12th, in the amount of \$2329.24 was approved, Also approved was the Lampasas County Chamber of Commerce Marketing Plan for the 2020 Budget.

Next on the agenda was the discussion regarding the renewal of Lampasas County Chamber of Commerce Tourism and Visitor Center Agreement with the City of Lampasas, which was also approved.

LAFTA requested \$1,507 in HOT Funds for the Artober Fest, as well. The funds in the amount requested (\$1,507) were approved and will be used for lodging and stipends for each artist in the event, brochures, and restroom facilities for the participants and attendees of the festival.

The City Council approved the "Lantern Lighting Event" in WM Brook Park Sulphur Creek on November 9th from 5pm to 8pm. The event will include live music and food from various food trucks. The lanterns and candles used will be biodegradable and will be supplied by the committee.

An amount of \$185,000 was approved for the purchase of a public restroom facility for Campbell Park.

Lampasas ISD Called Meeting



A LOOK at the BUDGET

Lampasas ISD held a called meeting Monday night at 6pm. The first action taken was the approval of the 2018-2019 final budget amendments. The general operating fund was approved for \$1.9 million, the food service fund was approved for \$5,230 and the Interest and Sinking fund was approved for \$258,149. A few of the major factors impacting the price was three school buses, a suburban, security camera upgrades at all three elementary campuses, softball and baseball netting and padding, and various other repairs and replacements.

Discussed and approved for \$183,284 was the 2019-20 accelerated instruction budget. This is used to support students in any subject in which the students failed to perform satisfactorily for graduation.

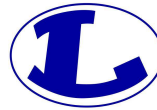
Adoption of the 2019-20 tax rate for maintenance and operation and interest and sinking was also approved. The total proposed property tax rate is 1.32835 per \$100 valuation, making maintenance and operations 1.06835 and interest and sinking fund was 0.26 per \$100 valuation
