The Weather



The high yesterday 92° This morning's low 71°
As Hurricane Laura moves off to the northeast, so do our chances of rain. The forecasters say a heat advisory may be issued for Friday and Saturday, maybe even Sunday. There should be relief from the oppressive heat early next week, and very low rain chances.

Today: Sunshine and a 96° high temperature this afternoon, with a 30% chance of showers and storms. The heat index could reach 100°. Look for light N breezes.

Tonight: Mostly clear, with a low around 76° and S winds near 5 mph.

Friday: Sunny and hot, with a high about 102° and S-SW wind near 5 mph. The heat index may reach as high as 106°.

Overnight Friday it will drop to about 76° and the wind will be S-SE at 10 mph with gusts of up to 20 mph.

Saturday: Sunny and hot with high temperatures near 101°. Winds will be S-SW at 5-10 mph.

Saturday night, look for clear skies and a low near 76°, with light SE winds.

Arson in Kempner

Shortly after 5am on Wednesday morning a fire was reported of f of County Road 4711 in Kempner. According to unverified reports, a resident of the neighborhood saw a suspicious person and tackled him, holding him for law enforcement. An unverified



report also states that this person was in the process of starting another house fire when he was stopped. The Lampasas County Sheriffs Dept. confirms that 37 year old Michael Paul Dunlap was arrested and booked in to the Lampasas County Jail on the arson charge out of Kempner. We will keep you updated on this story.

Hurricane Laura Arrives on Texas Coast

The storm was a Category 4 hurricane as it swept ashore. It had intensified as it neared the Gulf Coast and at 10 p.m., the hurricane center reported that the storm's maximum sustained winds had reached 150 mph — just 7 mph short of becoming classified as the most dire level of hurricane. The storm moved ashore in Cameron Parish, Louisiana — which borders Texas — around midnight Thursday after almost strengthening into a Category 5 storm, according to the National Hurricane Center.

Gov. John Bel Edwards tweeted that the interstate was closed eastbound at the Texas-Louisiana state line and westbound from the Atchafalaya Basin. The closure affects an estimated 120 miles of that interstate.

An image shared on social media showed the transmission tower for Lake Charles, Louisiana, TV station KPLC collapsed into a heap like a bunch of Tinkertoys. (below)



Good news, which is really premature, is that we have no reports of any deaths," he told Good Morning America on Thursday morning. "The storm continues to sweep through Texas in an unprecedented fashion because it's not just where the surge came in. [The storm] is going up north to Jasper and Center, Texas all the way up to Marshall, Texas so in northeast Texas a hurricane is going through there for, as far as I know, the first time ever."

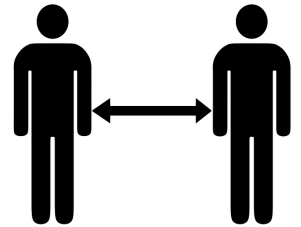

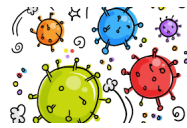
