The Weather



High yesterday was 85°

The low this morning was 69°

The showers that blew through Lampasas yesterday afternoon were hit-and-miss again. Hamilton received .75 inches yesterday, bringing their total rainfall for August to 2.34 inches. The Lampasas Airport recorded only .01, bringing the total to .21 for the month. There was no rainfall recorded at the Colorado River at Bend.

Today: Partly sunny with a high near 92° and a heat index near 97°. Calm wind becoming NE in the afternoon. An isolated shower or storm is possible this afternoon.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low near 75°, and an E-NE wind 5-15 mph becoming light and variable

Thursday: Mostly sunny with a high near 96° and heat index values near 102°. S-SW wind at 5 mph, and a 20% chance of showers after 8am.

Thursday night: The 20% chance of showers lingers until 8pm, then Partly cloudy with a low around 75°, winds SE at 5-10 mph.

Friday: A 20% chance of showers and storms after 8am, otherwise mostly sunny with a high near 96°, S winds at 5-10 mph.

Friday Night: The 20% chance of storms continues through the evening, then partly cloudy with a low of 73°. E-SE wind 5-10 mph.

The Weekend: The 20% shower and storm chances continue through the weekend, with highs in the low-to-mid 90's and the low temperatures in the low 70's

Lampasas County Commissioners will hold public hearings on the proposed tax rate for the county, with the 1st one being on Thursday, September 5th at 6:30pm, and the other on September 19th at 6:30pm. Both meetings will be in the County Annex Building Conference room.
