## County Commissioners

### Regular Meeting Yesterday

The Lampasas County Commissioners met yesterday morning for a regularly scheduled meeting. During the meeting Trisha Sneed was approved as administrative assistant to County Judge Randy Hoyer, the Interlocal agreement between Lampasas and Llano counties for jail service was accepted. Benefits for Lampasas Constables have ended; in a unanimous vote the benefits package for Lampasas County Constables totaling about \$11,000 per constable to cover medical and life insurance benefits is to be ended beginning October 4. Currently there is 1 Constable for our four Lampasas County Districts. There are benefits set aside for the remaining 3 vacant positions. The cost savings will put the earmarked revenue back into the county general fund.

The Special Election for November 7<sup>th</sup> was approved, and

Kempner Water Supply and Lampasas County are discussing the after effects of the repair process of the water main burst occurring in July.

## Commissioners' Workshop this Morning

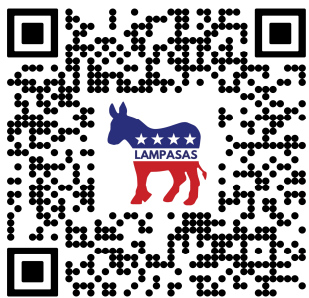
The County Commissioners are having a workshop meeting today at 10am in the Commissioners Courtroom to discuss the impact of Texas house bill 3697 on Lampasas County subdivision rules.

This Bill seems to limit the authority that County Commissioners have over land development in their counties.

## City Council Notes

The Lampasas City Council met yesterday for regularly scheduled meetings.

The Hostess House renovation process was discussed and is still in a holding pattern as the city is working with architects, engineers and contractors to secure plans and bids in order for Hostess House to meet code standards and compliance. Eclipse 2024 planning and preparation was a bulk of the discussion at last night's meeting. Costs and locations for tent and RV camping were discussed. The potential economic benefits for Lampasas are enormous. Likewise the concern of traffic flow and service efficiencies was also discussed. The Police and Fire Department Chiefs are also considering the need for added resources as the event draws nearer. Citizens also expressed concern about the need to balance the interests of Lampasas residents with the massive influx of people expected to descend on central Texas for the event. NASA will also have a telescopic presence here in town for the event that will be open to the public; more information to follow. Also discussed was a new 4 way stop sign at Spring and 4th Street. The Fire Chief's report stated that between August 28 of 2022 - 2023 there have been 1469 calls to serve. 1141 of these were car crashes and 69 were fire calls. The Lampasas City Fiscal year 2023/2024 budget currently enjoys a \$114,000 surplus. (cont'd on back)

## The Blotter

## City to Inspect Water Lines

The City of Lampasas has posted that it will begin on-site inspections of service lines beginning immediately.

The Environmental Protection Agency and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality have mandated all public water systems shall inspect City-owned and Customer-owned water service lines. City crews will be hydro-excavating portions of most service lines installed before 1994.

The City shared with Lampasas Radio that they will be digging near water meters to analyze the water lines. This should not take long at each residence and the city is hoping to keep inconveniences to customers to a minimum. If there is some kind of issue, they may need to dig up more of the water line, so it will be on a case-by-case basis. They are looking for evidence of lead in the pipes. This is part of The Biden-Harris Lead Pipe and Paint Action Plan

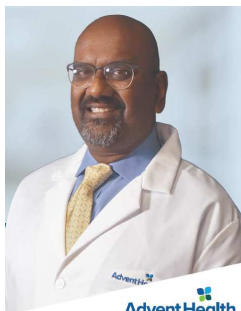
