# In Lampasas Radio Studios

This morning the City of Lampasas Fire Chief Jeff Smith joined Ronnie Witcher in our studios to talk about the fire business in Lampasas.

They spoke about the fire overnight off of S. Pecan St. by the creek. Chief Smith shared that the fire was called in at 12:50am and seems to be a debris pile that was started on fire. The fire department monitored the fire through the night and are certain the fire has been extinguished. Chief Smith said that today they will take it apart with a front end loader from the city and investigate how it started. No structures were threatened and the wind was calm so spreading was not a big issue.

They spoke about the wildfires in the area in the past month or so and how the drought and other weather conditions come together to make a perfect storm for fires. The humidity in the air is very important in these situations. During the heat of the summer you have ranchers welding and grinding, train tracks that can cause fires and safety chains on trailers dragging that can cause sparks. It does not take much! Be Cautious!

# City to Inspect Water Lines

The City of Lampasas has posted that it will begin on-site inspections of service lines beginning immediately.

The Environmental Protection Agency and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality have mandated all public water systems shall inspect City-owned and Customer-owned water service lines. City crews will be hydro-excavating portions of most service lines installed before 1994.

The City shared with Lampasas Radio that they will be digging near water meters to analyze the water lines. This should not take long at each residence and the city is hoping to keep inconveniences to customers to a minimum. If there is some kind of issue, they may need to dig up more of the water line, so it will be on a case-by-case basis. They are looking for evidence of lead in the pipes. This is part of The Biden-Harris Lead Pipe and Paint Action Plan.

# **ERCOT Issued Another Voluntary Conservation Notice Yesterday**

(Texas Tribune) The state's grid operator asked Texans to conserve electricity on Tuesday as some power plants fueled by gas, nuclear power, or coal unexpectedly went offline and wind power generation looked low. It's the seventh such request from the Electric Reliability Council of Texas this month amid intense heat and threats of a power-supply emergency.

ERCOT asked people to reduce their energy use between 5pm-9pm Tuesday, hours that are typically the most perilous for the grid because people returning home from work crank down their thermostats while solar power dwindles (cont'd on back)



# **Super-Blue Moon Tonight**

There will be a full moon appearing tonight that will be a supermoon and the closest supermoon of 2023. The moon will be 222,043 miles away. Comparatively, the average distance between Earth and the moon is 240,000 miles. It is the 3<sup>rd</sup> of 4 supermoons in a row; the next one will be September 28<sup>th</sup>. The Moon will appear full for 3 days around the peak of the full Moon, from Tuesday night to Friday morning. The planet Saturn, just a few days from its closest and brightest for the year, will appear near the Moon.
