District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on August 27th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 37 cases were brought to the court with 29 cases involving men, and 8 cases involving women. Yashira Mateo-Williams of Killeen failed to appear on a DWI charge, and Matthew Quinonez of Ft. Davis failed to appear on a possession of controlled substance charge, Shannon Reid of Lampasas failed to appear on the charge of continuous violence against family, and Angelica Gonzales failed to appear for possession of a controlled substance.

There were 13 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 5 cases for less than a gram, 4 cases for 1-4 grams, and 2 cases for 4-200 grams. There was also a case possession of a controlled substance/PG2 less than a gram. There were 2 DWI cases.

There were 4cases each for engaging in organized criminal activity, tampering with evidence and burglary. There were two cases for evading arrest.

Cases involving personal harm included 1 case for aggravated assault causing serious bodily injury; there was also 1 case of continuous violence against family and assault on a family/ household member. There were 2 cases each for sexual assault of a child, aggravated sexual assault of a child and indecency with a child/sexual contact.

Of the 53 cases, 5 were settled with Noel Graves Medina pleading guilty to Sexual assault of a child and receiving 5 years probation with ISF as a stipulation, plus court costs. Jessica Finley plead guilty to engaging in organized criminal activity and received 5 years probation plus court costs and a fine. Jamison Cavazos also plead guilty to engaging in organized criminal activity and was sentenced to 5 years probation, 40 hours of community service and court costs. Hanna Bruns plead guilty to possession of a controlled substance less than a gram and was sentenced to 5 years probation with SAFPF as a stipulation, and saw probation amended on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams.

The rest of the cases were reset or are awaiting trials.

Upcoming Vaccine Clinic

There is a vaccination clinic scheduled for tomorrow at the Lampasas Fire Dept. This will be done by the Texas Army National Guard, and they will have the Pfizer vaccination for those 12 years of age and older.

Coronavirus Update

According to the DSHS, statewide, 8,410 new cases were reported on August 30th and there were 1,470 probable cases and 33 fatalities. 13,768 Texans are hospitalized with the virus. Locally, on August 30th, the DSHS reported Lampasas with 36 new cases, and there have been 236 confirmed in Lampasas County in the last 14 days. The state estimate was 305 active cases.

Handicap Parking

As a reminder to our citizens, Texas Senate Bill 792 goes into effect on September 1, 2021. The bill requires recipients of the disabled veteran specialty license plate to hang an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) placard in their vehicle in order to park in an ADA designated spot. Displaying the disabled veteran specialty license plate only will no longer be enough to park in an ADA designated spot. You must also display the ADA placard as well.

On December 1, 2021, the Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) will require every recipient who applies for an ADA placard to get a doctor's signature on their application rather than the DMV automatically issuing one.

Public Tax Hearing for City of Lampasas

The City of Lampasas will have a Public Hearing on the tax increase for the 2021 tax year. The proposed new tax rate is \$0.3370 per \$100, up from the \$0.3217 per \$100 of last year.

A Public Hearing will be held on September 7th at 5:30pm in the City Council Chambers 302 E. 3rd St. Lampasas.



The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate (\$0.3530 per \$100). As a result, the City of Lampasas is not required to hold an election at which votes may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the City of Lampasas at their offices or by attending the public hearing.

The Mayor, TJ Monroe, as well as Randy Clark, Chuck Williamson, Herb Pearce, Zachary Morris and Bob Goodart voted for the proposal. Cathy Kuehne was absent.
