TxDOT Future Plans

Governor Greg Abbott today announced the adoption of the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) 2023 Unified Transportation Program (UTP), advancing a record \$85 billion, 10 - year statewide roadway construction plan. The 2023 UTP reflects an unprecedented level of projected transportation funding dedicated to improving transportation safety, addressing congestion and rural connectivity, and preserving roadways for Texas drivers.

"The State of Texas is working to ensure the transportation needs of our fast-growing state are met and that the safety of Texans on the roadways is protected," said Governor Abbott. "TxDOT's 2023 Unified Transportation Program is a critical step toward addressing the diverse needs of Texans in rural, urban, and metropolitan communities. This 10-year plan to address transportation needs statewide and dedicate \$85 billion to improve roadways will be a huge boon to our state's infrastructure and booming economy. As more people move to Texas and businesses grow across the state, we are working together to make sure Texans' transportation safety and mobility are secured and businesses can flourish for generations to come."

The UTP funds will coincide with an additional \$32 billion over the life of the program for routine maintenance contracts and project development, such as planning, professional engineering, and right-of-way acquisition for more than 7,000 transportation projects and a total investment of \$117 billion statewide. Projects that will improve safety, mobility, and connectivity next year in the nine-county Brownwood District include \$13 million preventative maintenance project throughout the district, \$15 million rehabilitation project on SH 6 in Eastland County, \$17 million

rehabilitation project on SH 16 in San Saba County, and \$16 million widening project on US 281 in Lampasas County. Included in this UTP, the Brownwood District has been designated a total of \$477,981,714 for future projects. Projects are selected by TxDOT and local transportation leaders based on effectiveness in addressing criteria such as safety, pavement condition, capacity, and rural connectivity, with opportunities for public input at both the state and local levels.

On the same day, at 6:15pm, the county will have their public hearing on the County Budget.

The City of Lampasas will hold their public tax hearing on Wednesday September 7th at 5:30pm at the Calvert Building on E. 3rd St.

The no-new-revenue tax rate would impose the same amount of taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. In most cases, the voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate a taxing unit can adopt without holding an election. In each case, these rates are calculated by dividing the total amount of taxes by the current taxable value with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.
