## The Weather



The High yesterday 95° The Low this morning 65°

The forecast for the next several days will be dominated by an upper ridge that is building; this ridge will be in full control of our weather, effectively doing away with any chance of rainfall for most of the week. Forecasters say that above normal temperatures, and mostly clear skies will continue through the weekend. This ridge will reach maximum strength Thursday-Saturday and we should look for triple digit days. However, the humidity seems to be lower, so heat index values will not be as high.

**Today:** A high temperature near 95°, and light and variable wind becoming easterly in the morning.


**Tonight:** Mostly clear with a low near 73°, and E wind near 5 mph becoming calm after midnight.

**Wednesday:** Sunny with a high near 96°, light and variable wind that will be easterly 5-10 mph in the morning..

**Wednesday Night:** Clear with a low near 73°, and E wind near 5 mph becoming light and variable by evening.

**The rest of the week:** High temperatures near 99°, and lows in the mid-70's.

## Meeting Tonight

 The City of Lampasas will be conducting a special joint meeting this afternoon at 5:30pm. This meeting includes the City Council and the Lampasas Economic Development Corporation Board.

The first order of business will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> public hearing concerning the proposed tax rate this afternoon at 5:30pm in Council Chambers at 405 S. Main St. in Lampasas. This hearing will be concerning all property subject to taxation within the City of Lampasas, for the fiscal year 2019-2020. There was no public input at the 1<sup>st</sup> public hearing last Monday.

Following the Public Hearing, Council will go into joint session to discuss Technology Infrastructure with the Lampasas EDC.

Following the Joint Session, Council will go to regular session for discussion and possible action regarding the contract for flatwork and accessibility ramp at the Old City Hall.

## \$13,000 Theft in Lampasas

The Lampasas Police Dept. is seeking the public's help in this case:

On the evening of August 29<sup>th</sup> the person in these images parked a dark colored hatchback or Jeep Cherokee type vehicle on 281 N in front of the business located at 1550 US 281 N in Lampasas.

The person then burglarized multiple vehicles stealing a large amount of tools and other items worth \$13,000. The person who committed the theft was on the premises for 2 ½ hours. The business owner shared with Lampasas Radio that they have been in this location for 6 years, and this is the 1<sup>st</sup> incident they have had with theft.

The person is described as a white or Hispanic man wearing a white Sherwin Williams T-Shirt, khaki light colored cargo shorts and tennis shoes.
