The Weather



Flooded Roadways

The high yesterday 75° This morning's low 69°
Lampasas County is under a flash flood warning until
12:30pm.

Area rain totals; Killeen Skylark has 2.47 inches in the past 2 days, The Colorado River at Bend had 2.24 inches in the past 24 hours, the Colorado River at San Saba has seen 3.36 inches in the past 2 days, Gatesville had 2.47 inches yesterday, and Hamilton has seen 2.99 inches in the past 48 hours. Burnet is showing 1.63 inches, and Temple with 4.96 inches. In Lampasas County, the totals vary from area to area, with 2.92 inches recorded between Kempner and Lampasas, and one area in the northern part of the county receiving 4.17 inches, areas north of Kempner have unconfirmed totals of 6+ inches.

As we have seen, the storms passing through our area are heavy rain-producers, and we are under a flash flood warning until 12:30pm. The forecasters say that the rain will decrease as the day goes on, with less rainfall to the north. Scattered showers and storms may form overnight, but will be isolated, and Central Texas may continue to see pockets of heavy rain through Friday and Saturday.

After a few days of drying out, the next cool front is expected Tuesday afternoon, with significant changes arriving Tuesday night.

Today: Partly sunny and an 88° high temperature this afternoon, with showers and storms likely, decreasing after 11am. Light wind from the SE at 5 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy, with a low around 71° and winds becoming calm. There is a 50% chance of showers and storms early Friday morning.

Friday: Partly sunny, with a high about 87° and light breezes from the E in the afternoon. There is a 60% chance of showers and storms, mainly in the afternoon.

Overnight Friday: There is a 60% chance of showers and storms in the evening. Otherwise, mostly cloudy with a low near 71°. The wind will become calm.

Saturday: Partly sunny with high temperatures near 90°. There is a 40% chance of showers and storms during the day, and winds will be light from the east.

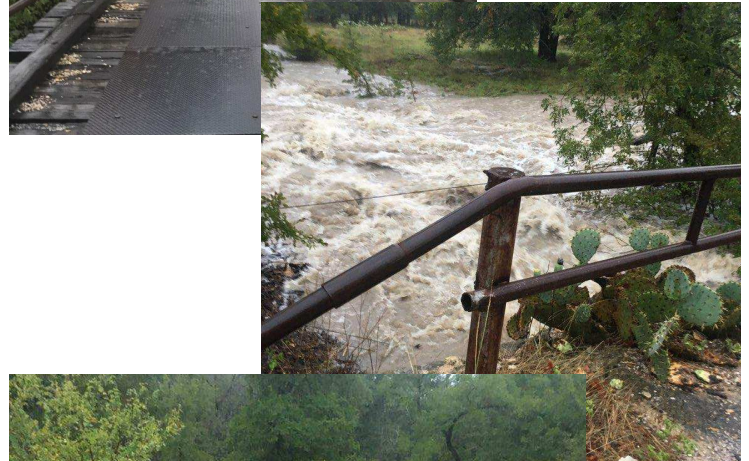
Saturday night: Look for partly cloudy skies and a low near 69°, with light E winds. There is a 40% chance of precipitation in the evening.

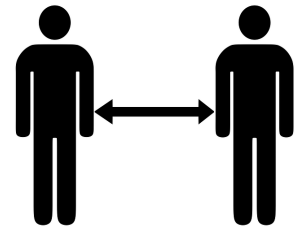
