### Badgers Win Big!

#### Lampasas 56 - Elgin 13



The Badgers came on strong from the kickoff, with Elgin sending it downfield and the Badgers taking it into the end zone on a short Ethan Moreno run after just five minutes. Kicker Landon Richardson got the Pat and the Badgers had a good early lead.

Elgin answered that one with a passing TD, but missed the PAT and the Badgers kept the lead. When the Badgers got the ball back again it was just 3 minutes and the Badgers crossed goal line again on a Dylan Sanchez to Ethan Moreno pass. Richardson made another good kick and it was 14-6 Badgers.

Elgin got the ball again but turned it over on downs in a couple minutes. Badger Daxton Brookerson took the ball on a 42 yard scamper for another TD and soon it was 21-6.

With the opening of the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter the Badger struck again on a pass play and PAT...28-6. In just another minute the Badgers went in again on an 11 yard Dylan Sanchez run and it was soon 35-6 with still 10 minutes left in the first half. Two more minutes and Dylan Sanchez threw a 26 yarder to sure-handed Nate Borhardt for TD number 6. After the kickoff Elgin tried again but had to punt. Lampasas did it again on a 26 yard run by Josh Carter.

The half finally ended with a 49-6 Lampasas lead.

Lampasas kicked off the second half to Elgin who changed QBs for the third quarter. The Badger defense continued to stymie the Wildcats and got the punt, but the Badgers were also held out,

having to punt for the first time. Elgin mounted another try, but after two plays they fumbled it up and the Badgers were at it again. They took the ball on Elgin's 31 and after runs by Luke Smith and Ethan Moreno and another PAT it was 56-6.

The Badger's offense failed to put any more points on the board in the game, while Elgin was able to get 7 more points before it was over.

Coach Troy Rogers team has thus far shown any doubters that they have plenty of football power and finesse, on both sides of the ball. Next week the Badgers will head to Wimberley to play their #31 ranked regional 4A team. It will likely be a good matchup. The game will be broadcast live over KCYL Radio and audio-streamed live at Lampasas Radio.com.

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 19,231 new and 7,384 probable new cases on August 27th, along with 302 deaths. There were also 13,851 Texans in the hospital with coronavirus. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 78 new confirmed cases in Lampasas county, and 252 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The DSHS website estimates 344 actual cases in Lampasas County for yesterday.

## Holiday Weekend Driving

AUSTIN – The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) encourages everyone to drive safely as they celebrate the unofficial end of summer during the long Labor Day weekend. The Texas Highway Patrol will be increasing enforcement from Sept. 3 through Sept. 6, looking for people not wearing their seat belts, speeders, people driving while intoxicated and drivers who fail to follow the state's Move Over, Slow Down law, among other traffic violations.

During the 2020 Labor Day holiday, Troopers issued 71,544 citations and warnings. This included 9,239 citations for speeding; 1,088 seat belt and child safety restraint citations; 1,419 citations for no insurance; and 534 warnings and citations for Move Over, Slow Down violations.
