The Weather

Lampasas County is under a Heat Advisory from noon today until 9pm tomorrow.

Today: Look for sunny skies with a high near 102°. Wind will be S near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies with the low dropping to about 76° by morning. Wind will be S near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny with a high temperature near 101°. Look for wind from the S wind to continue near 5-10 mph.

Wednesday Night: Look for mostly clear skies with a low near 77° and a SE wind at 5-10 mph.

Thursday: Sunny skies and the high will be near 103° with SW wind near 5-10 mph shifting S-SE in the afternoon.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low near 77° and S-SE wind near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Yesterday marked the 61st day this year of over 100° temperatures. This ties with the number of 100° days from 2011 and was the 5th day in a row of triple digits.

At 6:15 a public hearing will take place for input on the county budget for FY 2023-2024, and at 6:30 there will be a called meeting of the county commissioners to adopt the tax rate and budget.

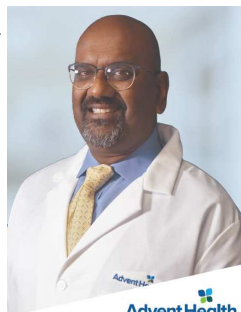
