Pecan St. A public hearing will take place at 6pm for comments about the Tax Rate for fiscal year 2022-2023. At 6:15pm, a public hearing concerning the county budget for 2022-2023 will take place. This will be followed by a called meeting at 6:30pm to adopt the budget and tax rate for the county.

Midterm Elections

(Texas Tribune) While there is no presidential election this year, eligible Texans can cast their ballots for state leaders and their district-based representatives.

The governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, comptroller, land commissioner and agriculture commissioner — who all serve four-year terms — are up for election.

Members of the state's Railroad Commission, which regulates oil and gas, and various state courts are up for election to six-year terms.

All U.S. representatives, state senators, state representatives and members of the State Board of Education are also up for election after the redrawing of political districts last year based on the 2020 census. U.S. and state representatives are elected to two-year terms while state senators and State Board of Education members draw lots to serve two- or four-year terms after the first post-redistricting election.

The last day to register to vote in the mid-term elections is October 11th. Early voting starts on October 24th and ends on November 4th. Mail in ballot requests must be received by October 28th, and November 8th is election day.

In our US House District, District 11, August Pfluger (R) is running unopposed. The Texas House District for our area, District 68 has David Spiller (R) running unopposed. Texas Senate District 24 for our region has Pete Flores (R) running against Kathy Jones-Hospod (D). The State Board of Education has 15 Districts and in our area, State Board of Education District 10, Tom Maynard (R) is running unchallenged.
