## Lampasas PD Pursuit

Lampasas Radio received the following from the Lampasas Police Dept.:

**On Wednesday September 9<sup>th</sup>**

at approximately 12:01am, Lampasas Police Dept. Sgt. Fidel Morua engaged in a pursuit of a dark colored sport type vehicle in the 900 block of N. Key Ave., in Lampasas. The vehicle was southbound on Key Avenue (South 183) at a high rate of speed, disregarding traffic control devices. Sgt. Morua pursued the vehicle in an attempt to stop it.



The pursuit traveled at high rates of speed, with Sgt. Morua unable to gap the distance between his patrol unit and the vehicle to at least obtain license plate information. The pursuit traveled from Lampasas to the intersection of S. Hwy 183 and FM 970 (the turn off for Andice), where Sgt. Morua could no longer see the vehicle he was pursuing, he followed department protocol and terminated the pursuit. He traveled to County Road 3405, still not seeing the vehicle. At County Road 3405, he turned around and returned to the City of Lampasas.

Later, Lampasas Police Dept. was advised of a tragic double fatality crash that had occurred at 180 and 183A in Leander, Texas. A vehicle similar in description to that which Sgt. Morua had pursued to stop was involved in a crash with a motorcycle.

Lt. Charles Montgomery is conducting further investigation with Leander Police Department to determine if the vehicle is the same vehicle that evaded Sgt. Morua.

Regardless if this is the same vehicle or not, we want to convey that our thoughts and prayers are with the family, friends, acquaintances and first responders of this tragic crash.



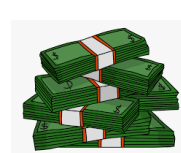

## Local Area Sales Tax Report



**Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar** announced Thursday 765.3 million in local sales tax allocations for September 2020, 4.5% less than in September 2019. These allocations are based on July sales from businesses that report tax monthly.

Kempner saw an increase of .08% for a rebate of \$10,310.82, and the City of Lampasas saw an increase of 12.6% for a rebate of \$192,199.54.
