The regular session of the City Council will begin at 6pm. The agenda for the regular meeting includes public hearings for the following: the program performance of the activities completed under the Texas Community Development Block Grant for a sewer improvement project, which will include an explanation of the actual use of the Texas Community Development Block Grant program funds and invite comments. A public hearing to receive citizen comments regarding a guesthouse being built at 101 N. Rice St. is also on the agenda.

Also included on the agenda will be the consent agenda, including discussion and possible action concerning the second reading of an Ordinance amending Appendix A (Fee Schedule) water rate of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lampasas providing for an increase in the rates to be charged for water service by the City of Lampasas. Also included will be routine matters to include the City Manager's Operational Report, discussion and possible action regarding a proposal from Schneider Engineering to provide engineering design for installation of four standby generators to serve the Water/Wastewater treatment plant, Water/Wastewater office, Spring St. Pump station, animal shelter and portable generators for lift stations in the amount of \$30,500. Discussion and possible action regarding a proposal from Schneider Engineering for adjustment to the City of Lampasas double circuit distribution that crosses US 281 and continues in the Naruna Road right-of way as part of the TxDOT project in the amount of \$16,200. Discussion and possible action concerning the first reading of an Ordinance setting the Tax Rate and levying a tax upon all property subject to taxation within the City of Lampasas.

Lampasas ISD School Board to Meet

The Lampasas ISD School Board will meet today in the Administration Building at 6pm for a regularly scheduled meeting.

The agenda includes the consent agenda to include a budget amendment, approval of expenses to purchase school buses and vehicles, and a request for a maximum class size exception waiver. Also included on the agenda is a list of bills, presentation and public comments regarding the "Safe Return to in-person instruction and continuity of services plan" and the "Use of Funds Plan" for the ESSER III grant. administrative reports and a long term facility plan for Hanna Springs Elementary.
