The Lampasas County Commissioners will meet today, Monday morning at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom. On the agenda is the consent agenda, discussion of a regulatory consulting agreement between Lampasas county and Joe England, the re-plat of the Rylan Ranch subdivision, a subdivision variance request by Glen Stephens, continued discussion of subdivision regulations, civil fees in the District Clerk's office, a request for 2 new fire safes in the District Clerk's office, and an Interlocal agreement between Lampasas County and Burnet County for Jail Services.

County Commissioners Called Meeting

The Lampasas County Commissioners will have a called meeting at 10:30 today in the 1st floor annex conference room in the county annex.

On the agenda will be conducting interviews for the vacancy for the unexpired term for Justice of the Peace Precinct 1, and selecting and announcing an appointee to fill the unexpired term of the Justice of the Peace Precinct 1.

Lampasas City Council Meeting Tonight

The Lampasas City Council will meet this afternoon in a workshop session at 5:30pm. The agenda for the workshop session includes a presentation by Vision Lampasas for a new mural, a Covid-19 update, and discussion regarding the Highway 281S improvement and widening project including access options for the Hostess House.

The Regular Session of the City Council will begin at 6pm with the agenda including the consent agenda, board and departmental reports, the city manager's report to include comments about E. 3rd St. sales tax, waste disposal for the city, building codes and the airport. This will be followed by the Mayor's comments, and new business. In new business the council will discuss the approval of the mural design for the building at 4th and Key, adopting a budget for fiscal year 2021-2022, (cont'd on back)

Board to Meet

The Lampasas ISD School Board will meet today at 6pm in the LISD Administration building at 207 W. 8th St. in Lampasas. The Agenda includes; the consent agenda, including second readings of policy updates, updated mission statement and goals, and approval of expense to purchase school buses. Also on the agenda is discussion of extension of employee benefits, administrative reports, and possible consultation with an attorney regarding petition for detachment and annexation.

Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 3,952 new and 410 probable new cases on September 12th, along with 166 deaths. There were also 13,230 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 3 new confirmed cases in Lampasas County on September 11th, and 271 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas County to have 398 active cases at this time.

Town Hall Meeting

The City of Lampasas has scheduled a Town Hall Meeting on September 16th at 5:30pm at the Hostess House. At the meeting, city officials will be rolling out adoption of new building codes for the City of Lampasas. All residents are encouraged to attend.

Upcoming Vaccine Clinic

There is a vaccination clinic scheduled for September 22nd from 9am-4pm at the Lampasas High School practice gym. The Pfizer vaccine will be available for those 12 years of age and older. Children 17 & under will need a parent with them.
