Lampasas County Commissioners Court

A Commissioners Court Meeting was held on Monday to discuss road improvements, local markets, lot vacancies and

police department resources. Important issues such as the vacant lot of what used to be the Lampasas County Jail and bullet resistant shields for the school district were discussed briefly. No decision was made in regards to the vacancy; while the latter received a passing motion. Planned expansion of US Hwy 183 is said to make 'highly needed' improvements to the traffic flow, according to comments made by Commissioner Jamie Smart. \$121,070 will be invested over the span of 5 years. An increase in fees for the Sherriff and Constable's office was approved.

Lampasas City Council

A Lampasas City Council Meeting was held on Monday evening to discuss the city budget, tax rate, and multiple hearings which were on the agenda. The budget for the city of Lampasas beginning on October 1, 2022 was approved, it will extend until September 30, 2023 and will increase the tax rate by 9.05%. It will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. Additionally, council members discussed regulations on short term rentals such as Air BNB and VRB, outlining zoning districts, parking restrictions, registration fees, etc.
