

Water Service Suspended for a Neighborhood in Cove

From the City of Copperas Cove: Emergency Cease and Desist Order: Cedar Grove Manufactured Home Community:



An inspection was conducted on the morning of Tuesday, September 13, 2022 at the Cedar Grove Manufactured Home Community with the following City of Copperas Cove Code of Ordinances violation being noted: Code Section 11-121 (Illicit Discharge) of the City's Stormwater Management Ordinance. At the time of the inspection, it was noted that an active sewage spill was continuing to discharge into a nearby waterway that is part of the City's MS4 system. This information is being shared with the community to help provide factual information due to conflicting information in the community.

Due to the previous warnings and past assurances that necessary repairs would be completed, along with continued violation today, the City's potable water system was suspended at approximately noon today for Cedar Grove Manufactured Home Community. During that time all residents were notified by City staff of the suspension of the City's potable water system. The attached Emergency Cease and Desist Order was prepared and issued to the appropriate property management prior to the disconnection of water services. City staff has remained on-site today in support of the property's management, making themselves available to provide information and guidance on how this situation can be resolved as quickly as possible. We encourage all affected residents to review the order, and specific questions should be directed to their property management.

Divorce Getting Too Expensive?

A recent survey by the E. W. Scripps company reveals that couples in Louisiana who desire to separate seemingly blame soaring inflation as a prevention from doing so.

One third (38 percent) of those couples say that if they wanted to separate from their partner, they could not afford to rent somewhere else to live on their own, according to a survey conducted by DivorceAnswers.com.

DivorceAnswers.com surveyed 3,026 couples to determine how many relationships are not being held together by love but by a higher cost of living because of inflation. Divorce can be quite expensive, averaging at least \$15,000 in attorney and legal fees.

Marriages are being held together based on these very factors. Record high inflation rates have also played a major role in the overall cost of living individually, mirroring the couples remaining married due to financial hardship.

The survey also concluded the following:

* Over half of singles would not get into a relationship with someone who has large debts.

* The average single said they would be deterred by a debt amount of \$33k. (cont'd on back)


