District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on September 10th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 25 cases were brought to the court with 20 cases involving men, and 5 cases involving women.

There were 4 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 3 cases for less than a gram, and 1 case for 4-200 grams. There was also a case for possession of a controlled substance/PG2 less than a gram. There were 2 DWI cases.

There were 4 cases for burglary, 3 cases for evading arrest, and two cases each for engaging in organized criminal activity, and 2 cases for burglary of a vehicle.

There were 4 cases for assault on a family member, and one case each for sexual assault, indecency w/ child sexual contact, and one case for invasive visual recording.

Of the 25 cases, 4 were settled with Clarita Aguirre of Georgetown receiving 12 months probation plus fines and court costs on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG2 less than a gram. Michael Schoolcraft plead guilty to DWI 3rd or more and was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ with credit for time served. On the charge of burglary of a habitation, Tyler Azar of Lampasas with sentenced to 2 days with 2 days of a credit plus fines and court costs. Stephen Denmon on the charge of indecency w/child sexual contact saw his charge reduced to injury to a child and received 3 years probation plus fines and court costs.

The rest of the cases were reset or had dates set for jury trials.

Coronavirus Numbers

Statewide, on September 14th, there were 17,373 new and 6,087 probable cases, along with 12,973 in the hospital. There were 296 deaths from Covid reported as well. Locally, in the last 14 days, Lampasas has seen 280 confirmed cases according to the DSHS website in the last 14 days, with 49 being confirmed yesterday. The state estimate is 418 active cases in Lampasas County.
