The Weather



The High yesterday 86° The Low this morning 70°

Today: Rainfall has a 30% chance in Lampasas today, mainly this afternoon, and otherwise the sun will be in and out of the clouds. The high should top out about 86° and the winds will be 5-10 mph and coming out of the N-NE.

Tonight: The rain chances drop to 20% overnight and the low should be around 69°. The sky will be mostly cloudy and the breeze out of the north at around 5-10 mph.

Thursday: There is a 30% chance of rain under partly sunny conditions, and the high should be near 84°. Winds will be from the N-NE at 5-15 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly cloudy with a low around 66°, and a 20% chance of rain. The wind will be N-NE at 5-10 mph.

Friday: The rain chances go away and the high temp should come to about 84°. Winds will be NE at 5-10 mph most of the time but perhaps gusting to 20 mph at times

Friday Night: Mostly clear sky, dropping to 62°, and NE wind that could be a little gusty at times.

The Weekend: At this point it looks like clear sky and a pretty nice weekend ahead.

They include Chasity Martin, Dennis Martinez, Samuel Rodriguez and Samuel Page. Ezequiel Cruton of Killeen, charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon is set for pre-trial on the 2nd too. Billy Joe Kirkham, charged with burglary of a building has an arraignment set for Oct. 2nd. Billy Tate Shoaf, charged with possession of a controlled substance and theft of property has been reset to October 30th. Orlando Matthew Foix, charged with burglary of a building is set

for pre-trial on November 6th, as is Colten Lane Young, charged with possession of a controlled substance. Zachary Austin Kelley is charged with aggravated sexual assault of a child and is set for pre-trial on Nov. 13th, as is Priscilla Marie Freasier of San Antonio, charged with DWI with a child on board.

Some finished cases included Angelica Marie Gonzales, charged with possession of a PG1 substance, who got a \$500 fine and restitution of \$180 to the DPS and courts. Angie Alvarado of Killeen, charged with possession of a PG2 substance will turn in a plea this week.
