## Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 20,201 new and 4,253 probable new cases on September 15th, along with 411 deaths, and 12,817 in the hospital.

Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 11 new confirmed cases yesterday with the 14 day total at 288 cases. The DSHS website estimates Lampasas at 426 active cases.
