The high yesterday 84° This morning's low 70°

The forecasters say that we may see some scattered showers as an upper trough pushes some moisture through our area. Also, a cold front is expected to make its way through Texas bringing highs in the 80's and lows in the 60's over the weekend. That will be the pattern for the next week, with only a gradual warm-up expected.

In the southwestern Gulf of Mexico a well defined low pressure system is quickly developing. If this development continues, a tropical depression/tropical storm could form. It is expected to hand around in the SW Gulf of Mexico before moving northeast. It is not expected at this time to have any impact on our weather.

Today: Partly sunny with a 30% chance of showers and storms this afternoon. The high temperature will be 86° with N-NE winds at 5-10 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy, with a low around 66° and winds becoming calm.

Friday: Mostly sunny a high near 83°. The wind will continue from the NE at 5-10 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Overnight Friday: Mostly clear with a low near 60°. The wind will be NE at 5-10 mph.

Saturday: Sunny with high temperatures near 81°. Winds will be NE at 5-10 with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Saturday night: Look for clear skies and a low near 57°, with light NE winds.

Governor Abbott to give Coronavirus Update

Gov. Greg Abbott will give an update on the coronavirus pandemic in Texas at noon Thursday. Abbott will be joined by Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick, House Speaker Dennis Bonnen and several state health officials. His press conference comes as recent key coronavirus statistics — including the number of cases, the number of people hospitalized with COVID-19 and the percent of people who test positive — have trended down in recent weeks. Abbott has hinted that he may ease some restrictions if numbers continue to fall.

Fall Free Breakfast & Lunch Meals

Effective on Monday September 21 Lampasas ISD will begin serving free breakfast and lunch meals to anyone 18 years old or younger. The free meals will be served through December 17th or until the USDA funds are exhausted. If your student or students charge any meals to their lunch account from the start of school to the present time (August 10th - September 18th) you are responsible for paying these charges.

The middle school and the high school will have a la Carte drinks available to students that are participating in on-campus instruction and have funds available on their meal accounts. Cash purchases in the serving line will not be allowed.

All "Grab & Go" meals are remote learner meals will be picked up at Taylor Creek Elementary from noon-1pm in the front of the building and at Lampasas Middle School from 10:50am to 11:20am by the loading dock near the cafeteria on 7th Street. Parents/Guardians will need to present one of the following: Student ID number, birth certificate for children not currently enrolled in school. 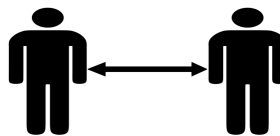
