Badgers Win Again



The Badgers played a solid game against the Pflugerville Connally Cougars on Badger field Friday, winning 44-14. Offensively, quarter back David Flores successfully passed to Owen Stubbs and Ethan Moreno for a 15yd touchdown and an 8yd touchdown, respectively. The Badgers passing game was 12 out of 23 for 183 yards and 4 touchdowns. Aden Rascoe had the only rushing touchdown in his performance of 10 carries for 124 yards with a touchdown, and 3 receptions for 43 yards and 2 touchdowns. Landon Richardson kicked 5 extra points. Ethan Moreno had 6 receptions for 98 yards and a touchdown.

The badgers played a strong defensive game, forcing a punt nearly every time the Cougars had the ball. Haegan Oncken had an interception in the 2nd quarter and Brock Langford blocked a punt, which was recovered by Dailin Fagan, Fagan then ran 10yds for a special teams touchdown.

Next week the Badgers host State-Ranked Wimberley at Badger Stadium for Homecoming.

To join 4-H, youth pay a \$25 fee, which increases to \$30 November 1, 2022. 4-H registration takes place online and that information or link can be provided by your local County Extension Agent or found on texas4-h.tamu.edu.

Adult volunteers register online and pay \$10 to be considered a registered 4-H volunteer. If you are interested in volunteering with the Lampasas program, contact your County Extension Agent for more information about where to plug in and how to get signed up.
