Save Me With A Seat

Vehicle crashes are a leading cause of death among children in the nation, so the Texas Department of Transportation is reminding parents that one of the most important things they can do to protect children is to properly install and use a car seat. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) states that 46% of all child car seats are misused.

TxDOT's "Save Me With a Seat" campaign kicks off in September to coincide with National Child Passenger Safety Week, Sept. 18–Sept. 24, 2022. The campaign invites parents to schedule a free car seat safety check by visiting SaveMeWithASeat.org and entering their ZIP code to find the nearest TxDOT Traffic Safety Specialist in their area. TxDOT offers free car seat safety checks year-round.

When child car seats are used correctly, they can help reduce injuries and prevent fatalities when children are involved in a crash," said TxDOT Executive Director Marc Williams. "We urge parents to schedule a car seat check today to ensure they are safely and correctly using the right car seat for their child."

With the "Save Me With a Seat" campaign, drivers are reminded that Texas law requires all children under 8 — unless they are taller than 4 feet, 9 inches — to be in a car seat whenever they ride in a



passenger vehicle. Failure to properly restrain a child can result in a ticket of up to \$250. Children under age 13 should ride in the back seat, properly secured in a seat belt or safety seat.

In 2021, 78 children younger than 8 years old died in traffic crashes in Texas, and 22 of those were unrestrained at the time of the crash. Among children ages 8–12 in 2021, 36 died in traffic crashes, with 13 of them unrestrained at the time of the crash. According to NHTSA, child car seats in passenger vehicles can reduce the risk of fatal injury in a crash by 71% for infants and by 54% for toddlers.

Governor Abbott Increases Efforts Against Fentanyl

Gov. Greg Abbott on Wednesday directed the Department of Public Safety to redouble its efforts combating Mexican drug cartels, which he blamed for transporting millions of doses of the opioid fentanyl into Texas.

"Fentanyl is a clandestine killer, and Texans are falling victim to the Mexican cartels that are producing it," Abbott said at a roundtable in Midland with DPS Director Steve McCraw and local law enforcement and political officials. (*cont'd on back*)

The Blotter

(cont'd from front) In a new executive order, Abbott directed the state police to, among other priorities, boost efforts to collect intelligence on cartels, investigate gangs in Texas that support drug and human smuggling, and seize goods the cartels are smuggling back to Mexico, including cash.

Abbott also sent a letter to the heads of state agencies asking them to work harder on combating the "fentanyl crisis." He asked them to prepare for the coming legislative session that starts in January, outlining budget priorities and other initiatives to decrease fentanyl deaths in Texas.
