 **The Lampasas City Council** will meet today in a Workshop session at 5:30, where the agenda includes discussion regarding Advisory Board term expirations and vacancies, discussion and updates regarding the Comprehensive Planning process and the operation and marketing of the Hostess House.

The Regular Session, beginning at 7pm has an agenda that includes discussion regarding temporary permits for Mobile Food Trucks, discussion about establishing the permitting process for pole attachments, and discussion and possible action of an Ordinance Amending the Fee Schedule of Solid Waste providing for an increase in the rates to be charged for residential solid waste collection. Monthly departmental reports will be discussed, as well as possible action referencing a request form the Kiwanis Club for approval to operate a circus, carnival or similar events within the city limits of Lampasas. Discussion about the FY tax rates, and a request for HOT funds by the Courtyard Square Association.

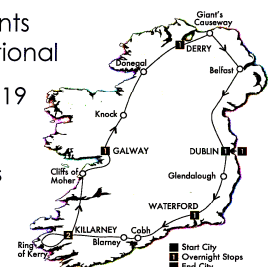

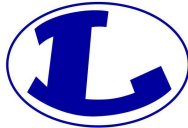
### Lady Badger Volleyball
