According to Dr. Rascoe, bus 8 was slowing on the east side of Kempner east bound on 190 to drop off a student. At this time, an eastbound dump truck collided with a Circle K gas truck (that was behind the bus) and pushed the gas truck into the bus (he was pushed a few hundred feet). 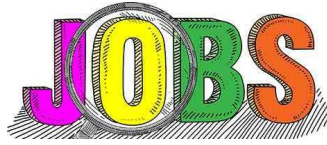

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept. for Thursday shows Lometa with medical calls, livestock issues and a requested welfare check. In Kempner officers tended to accidents, a reported disturbance, animal issues, juvenile problems, civil matters, and medical calls. Out in the county there was an accident, animal issues, reported threats and a warrant was served. Deputies went into Cove on a livestock issue.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of Jason Hedrick of Kempner for unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon. Also arrested was 36 year old Ashley Loyless of Austin on a probation violation and prohibited substance in a correctional facility.

The dump truck then collided with the bus on the door (passenger side) causing damage to the bus and ended up in front of the bus.

3 students were transported to the hospital with very minor injuries, out of caution. Dr. Rascoe is checking in with them today. The driver of the dump truck was transported by Care-Flight.

Dr. Rascoe wanted to thank Director of Transportation Beverly Spencer for her quick response, as well as Donna Clark, Clarissa Brown, Lt. Chuck Montgomery, the Mayor and city staff of Kempner, the first responders and others who assisted at the accident scene. The City of Kempner was very accommodating as the students were transported to Kempner City Hall as a meeting place where parents could pick up their children..

Dr. Rascoe said it could have been a much different scenario; a few feet one way or the other and the outcome would have been very different.
