Commissioner's Court


The Lampasas County Commissioners met Monday morning at the Lampasas County Courthouse. During the meeting the new tax rate of .712690 was approved for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020, which is a 5.48% increase.

Also approved were The Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, and the Inter-local agreement between Lampasas and Burnet Counties regarding jail services.

In other agenda items, the Commissioners named their nominees to be considered in the upcoming Central Appraisal District Board of Directors Election.

Attending the Commissioner's Court meeting was a group of young positive role models, the 4-H kids! Judge Hoyer proclaimed October 6th-12th as 4-H week.

City Council Notes

 **Lampasas City Council met** yesterday afternoon. During the regular meeting of the Lampasas City Council the following items were addresses: A proclamation to designate October 6-12 as "Fire Prevention Week".

The approval of the Consent Agenda regarding temporary permits for "Mobile Food Vendor Units".

The approval of the second reading of an ordinance adopting pole attachments and specifications for the City of Lampasas

The rate increase of \$1.25 for Residential Solid Waste Collection to go into effect the first billing in October 2019..

Finley deGraffenried. discussed the Citizens' Police Academy, which is a 12 week program that will begin on January 2, 2020. The Academy includes programs on Police operations, City Government, and Law Enforcement issues. **Applications are due by December 20th.** Upon completion the attendees may join/ participate in the Citizens' Police Academy Alumni Association.

National Night Out, the annual public safety open house, will be held on October 1st from 6pm at 8pm in the HEB parking lot. The event will include representatives from local and state public safety departments and agencies, as well as public service organizations.

The City's Noise waiver between the hours of 11pm-12am, midnight, was brought up by Finley to the Council for consideration due to the increase in local music venues

New Business included approval of the Ordinance Authorizing the issuance of the City of Lampasas General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2019. The Ordinance calls for the issuance of the \$1,400,000 to refund the Series 2011 Bonds. The final Ordinance was given last night which included the estimated savings prior to bids being received in the amount of \$192,000. The council approved the levy of an Ad Valorem Tax in support of the Bond and awarded the Sale of the Bond to Chase.

Next was the approval of a request from the Kiwanis Club for a license application to operate a Carnival, circus and similar event within the city limits of and to grant a waiver for operations near schools, churches, and private residences.

The proposed budget for the 2019-2020 Fiscal year was approved. As well as, the motion to adopt the ordinance that sets the tax rate to be increased by a rate of \$0.395218, which is effectively a 1.72% increase in the tax rate.

Chief Bailey requested to allow ASJ Construction, LLC to complete the interior paint project of the Lampasas Police Department. ASJ Construction, LLC submitted the lowest estimate of \$16,850. Chief Bailey stated that the police department would like to pay for the interior painting with the remaining \$10,860 from the LCRA grant, \$5,990 in unspent money in the 2018-2019 budget and save \$3,000 by moving computer and disconnecting the electrical equipment themselves. The Council approved her request.

The Lampasas Animal Shelter requested permission to dispose/sale of a 2001 Dodge pickup. The pickup has an odometer reading of 111,875 miles and is in need of several minor repairs. Council approved the request

Lastly was the discussion and consideration for a possible nominee(s) for the Lampasas Central Appraisal District Board of Directions. No nominations were made by members of Council and moved to place no action of the discussion. The election will be the term of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021. The City of Lampasas will have a total of 299 votes to cast in the election of the Board.

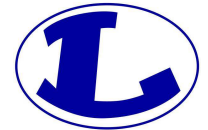
