**Today:** Skies will be mostly cloudy with a high temperature near 91°, and a 30% chance of showers late in the afternoon. Winds will be S-SE at 5-15 mph.

**Tonight:** Cloudy skies and showers and a 60% chance of thunderstorms in the evening. The low temperature will dip to near 69°, and winds will be S-SE at 10-15mph.

## Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 4,853 new and 939 probable new cases on September 27th, along with 38 deaths. There were also 9,719 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 16 new confirmed cases in Lampasas County on September 27th, and 155 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas County to have 259 active cases at this time.

## Register to Vote

(Texas Tribune) There's a statewide election on Nov. 2, but it's one without any statewide candidates.

Instead, the election will feature eight statewide constitutional amendments that address topics ranging from religious freedom to taxes to judicial eligibility. The last day to register to vote is Oct. 4. The last day to apply for a ballot by mail is Oct. 22. Early voting in the state runs Oct. 18-29.

Today is National Voter Registration Day

Texans need to fill out a voter registration application at least 30 days before the election. You can request the application through the mail or find one at county voter registrars' offices, post offices, government offices or high schools. While you can't register online to vote in Texas unless you're updating your driver's license, you can print out the online application and mail it to the voter registrar in your county. Applications have to be postmarked by the Oct. 4 deadline.



## Special Election for Texas

Governor Greg Abbott has issued a proclamation setting Tuesday, November 2, 2021 as the special election day for eight proposed constitutional amendments in Texas.

The eight proposed amendments are

**PROPOSITION 1:** The constitutional amendment authorizing the professional sports team charitable foundations of organization sanctioned by the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association or the Women's Professional Rodeo Association to conduct charitable raffles at rodeo venues.

**PROPOSITION 2:** The constitutional amendment authorizing a county to finance the development or redevelopment of transportation or infrastructure in unproductive, underdeveloped, or blighted areas in the county.

**PROPOSITION 3:** The constitutional amendment to prohibit this state or a political subdivision of this state from prohibiting or limiting religious services of religious organizations.

**PROPOSITION 4:** The constitutional amendment changing the eligibility requirements for a justice of the supreme court, a judge of the court of criminal appeals, a justice of a court of appeals, and a district judge.

**PROPOSITION 5:** The constitutional amendment providing additional powers to the State Commission on Judicial Conduct with respect to candidates for judicial office.

**PROPOSITION 6:** The constitutional amendment establishing a right for residents of certain facilities to designate an essential caregiver for in-person visitation.

**PROPOSITION 7:** The constitutional amendment to allow the surviving spouse of a person who is disabled to receive a limitation on the school district ad valorem taxes on the spouse's residence homestead if the spouse is 55 years of age or older at the time of the person's death.

**PROPOSITION 8:** The constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of all or part of the market value of the residence homestead of the surviving spouse of a member of the armed services of the United States who is killed or fatally injured in the line of duty.



## Pfizer studying oral covid-19 drug

Pfizer announced Monday it has reached the mid-to-late stage portion of a large study to find an oral antiviral drug against COVID-19. Its purpose would be to prevent infection among people who have been exposed to the virus.

The study is seeking up to 2,660 healthy adults ages 18 and older who live in the same household as someone who is confirmed symptomatic with COVID-19, the pharmaceutical maker said in a statement.

The treatment would combine the novel oral antiviral candidate PF-07321332 with a low dose of ritonavir. Ritonavir was approved in 1999 by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for treatment of HIV in adults and children older than one month, according to the National Institutes of Health's HIV.gov website. These days, ritonavir is most commonly used to boost the performance of other HIV drugs.

Participants would be in a double-blind, double-dummy study broken up into three groups. Participants would either get the PF-07321332/ritonavir combination for 10 days, a placebo for 10 days or the drug combo for five days followed by a placebo for five days.

"The primary objective will assess safety and efficacy for the prevention of confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection and its symptoms through Day 14," Pfizer said.

Dr. Sujatha Reddy of Northside Hospital in Atlanta said it reminds her of another type of treatment: Tamiflu.

"We give that to people that are exposed to the flu or early on in their diagnosis to try to keep them from getting very sick," she said.

This is Phase 2/3 of the clinical trial. Pfizer said Phase 1 "demonstrated that PF-07321332 was safe and well tolerated.

NIH said the study is expected to be completed by Dec. 25.
