Public Swimming Access to Sulfur Creek *Dakota Decker*

Since 1986, residents of Lampasas have not been able to swim in the very waterway that built our town - Sulfur Creek. Lately in our small Texas town, we have been on a historic restoration streak, so it only makes sense for Sulfur Creek to be in the sights of historic healing.

37 years later, and an online petition of 650 signatures + a paper petition of 100 signatures, the Lampasas City Council and the Parks and Recreation Board approved Sulfur Creek for reopening.

Before swimming can occur, the creek needs to be **cleaned of trash and inspected**. They will be putting up warning signs for swimming since there are no lifeguards.

Armando Rosales and Tammy Martin created the petition at the beginning of August with a dream. The petition is over **750 signatures**. This is proof any idea can make a change for anything anyone sets their minds too.



District Court Docket

There were seven cases and 4 people presented in Judge Gauntt's courtroom on Friday, September 27th.

Two of these cases were involving drugs. There was one case of Possession of a C1 Controlled Substance. One case was of Manufacturing a Controlled Substance, charged against Michael Oran Woods of Kempner. There was one DWI case with 3rd or more previous convictions. There was one case with Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, charged against Micheal Oran Woods. There was one case of Tampering and Fabricating Evidence with Intent to Impair.

There were two violence related cases. One was for an Assault on Family Member with Previous Conviction. The second was for **Murder, charged against Micheal Oran Woods** who pled guilty to Assault with a Deadly Weapon. He is sentenced to twenty years in prison.
