## The Weather

The High yesterday 71° The Low this morning 41°



**Today:** Some fog for the morning, then sunny this afternoon with a high near 70° and south wind 10-15 mph with gusts to 20.

**Tonight:** Mostly cloudy with a low around 49° and S-SW wind around 10 mph.

**Thursday:** Partly sunny with a high to 52° by about 9am, then it starts falling and will get down to around 44° for the remainder of the day. The SW wind that could be 10-15 mph early in the day will shift to N-NW and come with a vengeance – about 25-30 mph typically and gusting up to 35 mph. Hold on to your hat!

Thursday night the temperature will likely fall to about 31° with northerly winds gusting to 30 mph.

**Rest of the week:** Friday will bring a little sunshine and a high up to 55° and northerly winds as the cold front does its thing, dropping temperatures to 31° Friday night, a high of only 46° on Saturday, and down to 25° Saturday night. There will be a slight warm-up on Sunday as southerly breeze returns.

On Monday and Tuesday, we'll likely see rain chances.
