The Weather



High yesterday was 63° The low this morning was 53°

Today: Partly sunny with a high to 55° by about 11am, then falling to around 41° for the remainder of the day. The SW wind will be 10-15 mph early and will shift to N-NW later and come with a vengeance – about 25-30 mph typically and gusting up to 40 mph. Trash cans may roll!

Tonight: Mostly clear, with a low now thought to be around 29° overnight. The N-NW wind will be 15-25 mph with gusts to 35 mph.

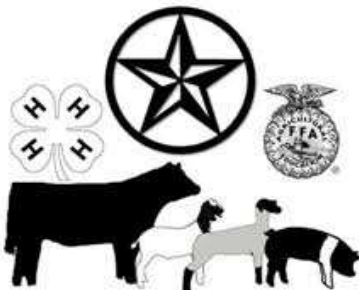
Friday: The sun will be out all day with a high near 53° and N-NW wind between 5 and 15 mph with gusts to 20 mph. Overnight it will be clear and down to 28° with light NE wind.

The weekend: A high of only 46° on Saturday, and down to 25° Saturday night. The wind will be NE and fairly light.

Sunday the high will be about 49° with the wind shifting back to southerly and very light. Sunday night the low will be in the lower 30s. Monday it will be sunny and up to 56° and rain chances come Monday night and into Tuesday.

The 81st Annual Lampasas County Youth Livestock Show began this morning at the show barn north of town. For the new-in-town not familiar with our stock show, the show barn is on the west side of the intersection of Hwy 281N and Hwy 183/190W.
