The Weather

High yesterday was 64° at the airport

The low this morning at gauges around the area were dipping to as low as 24° at Lometa, 27° just SW of Lampasas and 26° in Lampasas.

There were a few minutes of sleet in Lampasas yesterday around 4pm. There was snow west of Lampasas that registered .01in. in Lometa. Reports from Goldthwaite indicated blinding snow for a few minutes.

Today: Sunny, with a high near 53° this afternoon and N-NW wind 5-15 mph with gusts to 20.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low around 26° and NE wind 5 mph.

Saturday: Mostly Sunny with a high near 45° and N-NE wind between 5 and 10 mph. Overnight it will likely drop to 25° and the N-NE wind will be light at 5 mph to calm.

The rest of the weekend: The Sunday forecast calls for a high near 53° and a wind shift back to southerly at 5-10 mph. The overnight Sunday will stay above the freezing point, probably around 53°.

M.L.K. Day will be mostly cloudy and up to 59° with a nice southerly breeze but the cold will likely return Monday night. The long range forecast calls for a 40% chance of rain and snow and more cold north wind.

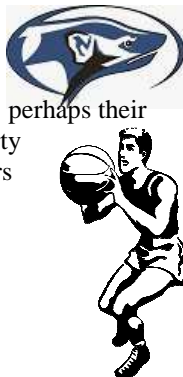
