The Weather



The High yesterday was 65° The Low this morning 24° at the airport, 21° at Lometa and most spots west of town. Wind was gentle and southerly until about 6pm Monday. Within minutes it shifted to north, and by 7:30pm we had gusts of 30 mph.

Today: Chances of snow or sleet have gone down in our forecast from 40 to 20% as it appears the moisture coming up from the south is veering more to the east before it gets to our area. The high, under somewhat cloudy skies, is expected to be about 31°, a few degrees higher than was forecast earlier. The wind chill will still be low, 9-19°, and the north wind is still expected to be fierce, at 15-20 mph and gusting to 25.

Tonight: The overnights are always the worst part of winter, with this part of the forecast predicting a drop to 13°, even worse than we had expected in yesterday's forecast. At least, the N-NE wind will drop down to 5-10 mph.

Wednesday: Our mid-week forecast seems to call for a gradual warming up as Wednesday is expected to be sunny with a high near 36° with north wind dropping and turning easterly. Overnight we still expect another freezing low of 20°

The rest of the Week: Thursday will bring sunshine and a little warmer day, up to 45°, and the wind will shift to south. On Friday it will be partly sunny with a high getting close to 60° Saturday comes into our forecast for a high near 69° and a chance of rain may show up Saturday night or Sunday.

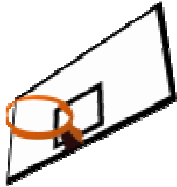
