The Weather



Yesterday's high was 47° This morning's low 39°

Today: Mostly sunny, with a high near 55° this afternoon and S-SW wind 5-15 mph with gusts to 20.

Tonight: Increasing clouds with a low around 44° and south wind 10 mph.

Saturday: Cloudy through mid morning, then clearing with a high around 71° and S-SW wind between 10 and 15 mph with gusts to 20. Overnight it will be increasingly cloudy with a low around 53° and south wind will be 10-15 mph and gusty.

The rest of the weekend: The Sunday forecast calls for a 30% chance of some sort of rain, otherwise cloudy and up to 71° in the afternoon. The south wind will continue at 10-15 mph and gusty for the day but it will shift to west overnight.

Next week we see another wind shift on Monday, back to N-NW with the arrival of a new cool front that seems to be weak. It should bring mid 30s overnights and low to mid 60s afternoons at least to mid-week.


